
In Paul's day ... small ships would be rolled across this old paved road



Most famous Temple of Aphrodite on top of the Acrocorinth ... aahh, somewhere

Aphrodite – Goddess of Love, Beauty Pleasure, and Sex (Roman Venus)

Greek Philosopher, Historian Strabo (63 BC-AD 24) said in 2 BC

Temple *EMPLOYED* 1,000+ *hetairai*

Higher-priced Prostitutes – "Companions"

Higher than normal pornai - prostitutes

Aphrodite, Parian marble, Roman copy of 2nd c. AD of Greek original of 4th c. BC

Temple of Aphrodite "prostitutes" date back centuries BEFORE Paul to 800 BC, fully developed by 500 BC ahh ... Golden Age of Greece

1,000+ *hetairai* hired "companions" often not per act, but for days/weeks

So high-priced, ship captains said,

"voyage to Corinth is not for every man"

1000 BC Corinth founded by Dorian Greeks.

657-627 BC Corinth prospered under the rule of the tyrant Cypselus.

627-585 BC Corinth reached its high point under Periander, son of Cypselus.

582 BC First athletic games were held at Isthmia.

243 BC Corinth joined the Archaean League.

146 BC Corinth destroyed by Rome's General Lucius Mummius.

44 BC Julius Caesar rebuilt Corinth as a Roman colony.

27 BC Corinth made capital of Senatorial Province of Achaia.

AD 15 Corinth made part of Imperial Province of Macedonia.

AD 50-51 Paul, on his second missionary journey, made his first visit to Corinth and established a church.

AD 57 Paul, on his third missionary journey, spent the winter in Corinth and wrote the Book of Romans.

AD 67 Nero began digging the Corinth Canal; the project was abandoned after three months.

AD 77 Corinth was destroyed by an earthquake and slowly rebuilt afterward.



Goes to Ephesus with Aquila & Priscilla

They want Paul to stay in Ephesus, but he sails to Jerusalem

In Ephesus Aquila & Priscilla instruct Apollos who wants to go to Achaia –

Corinth capital of Roman Province of Achaia







FOUR Letters Storyline

Acts 19:1, While Apollos was at Corinth, Paul took the road through the interior and arrived at Ephesus.



- 1. Lost Letter in 1 Cor. 5:9

While in Ephesus Paul writes

Lost Letter 1 Cor. 5:9

"5:9" Lost Letter not successful, as 1 Cor. 1:11, Chloe's House informs



Plus! ... 1 Cor. 16:17-18, Stephanas, Fortunatus, Achaicus come to Ephesus ... tell Paul more

Paul writes 1 Corinthians from Ephesus near end of two years in Ephesus



19:21, After all this [Riot in Ephesus] ... Paul decided to go to Jerusalem, passing through Macedonia and Achaia. "After I have been there," he said, "I must visit Rome also."

Acts 20:1 Paul leaves Ephesus for Macedonia & Achaia ... Corinth capital of province of Achaia

Acts 20:2, He traveled through that area, speaking many words of encouragement to the people, and finally arrived in Greece...

From 2 Corinthians, we see Paul's feelings after his 2nd visit to Achaia and Corinth





After Corinth & heading north again thru Macedonia

- 2 Corinthians tells us of SEVERE LETTER (we don't have)
- 2 Cor. 2:4, For I WROTE you out of great distress & anguish of heart & with many tears, not to grieve you but to let you know the depth of my love for you.
- 2 Cor. 7:8-9, Even if I caused you sorrow by my LETTER, I do not regret it. Though I did regret it ... yet now I am happy ... because your sorrow led you to repentance.

We don't have that Severe Letter

Yet, some see 2 Cor. 10-13 as part of that Severe Letter

- Paul in Macedonia hears about Corinthians' RESPONSE to that 3rd Severe Letter ...
- In Macedonia heading to Troas ... remember ... where Paul speaks ALL night & young man falls out of window
- In Macedonia, Paul writes 2 Corinthians
 - 2 Cor. 12:14, Now I am ready to visit you for the third time ... what I want is not your possessions but you.
 - 2 Cor. 13:2, I already gave you a warning when I was with you the second time. I now repeat it ...
- 2 Corinthians is Paul's Fourth Letter ... KINDER

FOUR Letters to Corinthian Christians

- 1. Lost Letter, 1 Cor. 5:9
- 2. 1 Corinthians
- 3. Lost Severe Letter, 2 Cor. 2:4, 7:8-9

From 1 Cor. 1 ... see SEVERAL congregations

Toss into this ... the **Book of Ephesians** is considered a cyclical book, meant to be read to SEVERAL churches

All this to say ... at the START of 1 Corinthians

Paul has a NETWORK informing him ALL OVER



Written to several congregations in Corinth

Paul has a NETWORK informing him from ALL OVER

APPARENTLY ... the churches in Corinth

- ✓ Love Paul
- Listen to Paul
- ✓ Take to HEART Paul's words

All over ... Paul is the avowed leader of the church

Peter ... "Rock" ... meant his "Confession of Christ = Rock"

Paul ... not only has a network ... he has the Spirit

Have we travelled round the world to get to the other side of the street? ... *Hopefully Not!*

Serendipitous Treasure ... hitherto uncovered

Treasure is this:

- ✓ Paul NETWORKED ... Loved Unity SO MUCH
- ✓ Paul held HEARTS so dear ... OTHERS helped
- ✓ Paul CHERISHED UNITY so much ... he wrote much

Storyline of the Four Letters ... is between the lines

Two LOST Letters ... imply perhaps many other LETTERS

4 Letters = Paul's CONNECTION for years

over 1,000s of miles & 100s of cities ... unifying



Not intended by Dr. Luke in Acts ...

Not intended by St. Paul in 1 & 2 Corinthians ...

Serendipitous Treasure ... hitherto uncovered

- **✓ Paul NETWORKED ... Loved Unity**
- ✓ Paul worked at Unity while ABSENT from Corinth
- ✓ Worked Corinthian Unity 300 miles away in Ephesus
- ✓ Worked for Corinth while TRAVELLING 1,000+ miles







12 What I mean is this:

One of you says, "I follow Paul"; another, "I follow Apollos"; another, "I follow Cephas"; still another, "I follow Christ."

What? ... at least FOUR congregations!




- 13 Is Christ divided?Was Paul crucified for you?Were you baptized in the name of Paul?
- ¹⁴ I thank God that I did not baptize any of you except Crispus and Gaius,
- ¹⁵ so no one can say that you were baptized in my name.
- ¹⁶ Yes, I also baptized the household of Stephanas; beyond that, I don't remember if I baptized anyone else.

Tad sarcastic ... facetious ... or just humorous





17 For Christ did not send me to baptize,
 but to preach the gospel—
 not with wisdom and eloquence,
 lest the cross of Christ be
 emptied of its power.



We could be tempted to think Paul used "wisdom & eloquence" to mean "fancy speech"

Then, in high-class Corinth & the Greek mainland ...

Throughout the Roman Empire ... RHETORIC reigned



Greeks made RHETORIC as science itself

Aristotle 384–322 B.C., tutor to **Alexander the Great**

Wrote a horde of books on philosophy, science, politics, ethics


Wrote the book Rhetoric ... circa 300 B.C.

Many have translated the Greek version

POINT – Greek plays & Lawsuits depended upon FINE speech ... ART of persuasion


Paul KNEW this ... as "artful" as Paul was

Christ did NOT send to PERSUADE



by Lysippos from 330 B.C.

For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.



¹⁹ For it is written: "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise; the intelligence of the intelligent I will frustrate."

Salvation in Christ ... has an inherent simplicity.

In the "Confession of Christ" – the Rock – All Saved

To DRIVE this home ... Paul slips in Rhetoric of his own



Where is the wise person?
 Where is the teacher of the law?
 Where is the philosopher of this age?
 Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the wor



²¹ For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not know him,

God was pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to save those who believe.

By "foolishness," Paul was pointing to himself.

Paul, Ex-Enforcer, now a Church Planter—foolish!



In an artful FURTHERMORE, Paul says

²² Jews demand signs and Greeks look for wisdom (read science, rhetoric),

²³ but we preach Christ crucified (*implying "raised" to* a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles,

Implied ... with no sleight of hand ... yet so artfully

For Christians ... Christ Crucified & Raised is


ALL ... EVERYTHING





Our UNITY depends on AGREEMENT upon a few tenets many Jews & Greeks Find Foolish

but to those whom God has called,
 both Jews and Greeks,
 Christ the power of God and
 the wisdom of God.



²⁵ For the foolishness of God is wiser than human wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than human strength.

Paul leads them to UNITY ... in his Second Letter



Paul's Second of FOUR Letters ... we know as 1 Corinthians

Paul encourages them to AGREE ...

AGREE on the essentials of Christ Crucified

They have some trouble with that ... cause

- ✓ Paul will visit them AGAIN
- ✓ Paul will write a 3rd Lost Severe Letter
- ✓ Paul will CONTINUE to Keep Track of them
- ✓ Finally, Paul writes a 4th Letter: *our* 2 Corinthians

 If there is any KEY to Unity it is Networking!







Paul did not merely "preach" and leave Paul LOVED them enough to Keep Track

- ✓ Keep Track without telephones ... email
- ✓ Keep Track without Facebook & Twitter
- ✓ Keep Track without Cell Phones

You understand ... Paul's appeal to Unity

Flows through his careful Networking

Corinthians LOVE Paul ... they accept these letters

Paul LOVES them ... so much, he LEARNS their needs

KEY to Learning Needs = NETWORKING





Oh my ... my oh my ... How Paul LOVED them ... to KEEP TRACK We have trouble KEEPING TRACK of our CLASS Some move ... will move ... never hear again Paul ... the Greatest Christian ... LOVED Like Christ LOVES & keeps TRACK too Jesus said in Matthew 10:29-31

²⁹ Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground outside your Father's care.



Apostle Paul, c. 1657

Yes ... God is keeping track of you Matthew 10:29-31

³⁰ And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

31 So don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows.

That leads me a closing question.
