



Nazarite vs. Nazarene - two different words

Nazarite Vow

- "nazir" Hebrew for consecrated or separated
- **ü** Numbers 6:2-21 No wine, No cut hair, no contact corpses
- ü By declaration: 1. Set time,2. Permanent, 3. Like Samson
- **ü** Three: Samson, Samuel, John the Baptist, and Paul joined others in their vow Acts 21

Incidental – Jesus was consecrated to God from birth as were the two clearly dedicated Nazarites Samson & Samuel

Nazarene & Nazareth

- "Nazarene" only once in N.T., referring to Jesus in Matt. 2:23
- **ü** Greek form of Hebrew "netser" for branch or sprout; Isa. 11:1 Messiah is Netse, "Branch"
- ü Acts 24:5 Christians are followers of sect of Nazarenes
- Town "Nazareth" NOT in O.T. & meaning uncertain, but could mean "watch tower" as it could be connected to hill behind it
 A "Nazarene" is from Nazareth


Woe Unto Israel

¹ "Samuel's word came to all Israel"—Go Fight! until 7:2 – don't hear from Samuel for 20+ yrs? i.e., chapters 4-6 = 7 months, then 7:2 = 20 yrs!



4:2-4 - Israelites face Philistines.

- Israelites at Ebenezer
- Philistines at Aphek.
- Philistines kill 4,000!
- Israel wants Ark to come and save them—help!
- Ark from Shiloh to Ebenezer





Ark of the Covenant

Who, What, Where

Ex. 25:10-22 & 37:1-9

- ✓ Moses given specs on Mt. Sinai
- ✓ Ark made by Bezalel to specs 4'2" long x 30" high
- ✓ Made of acacia overlaid in gold
- √ Two angels faced each other
- ✓ Same from Exodus to Temple
- ✓ Temple of Solomon, two huge angels stand on each side made of olive wood overlaid in gold



Placed inside Tabernacle in the Holy of Holies

Carried for 40 Years in Wilderness
Carried during Conquest
Went before Joshua at Jericho
Resided at Shiloh after Conquest

After Shiloh???

- From Ebenezer Tours Philistia
- ✓ Returned to Beth-Shemesh
- √ To Kiriath Jearim
- ✓ David placed with Obed-Edom for three months
- ✓ David put in tent in Jerusalem
- √ Then in Solomon's Temple
- ✓ Temple destroyed 586 B.C. & it not mentioned with vessels taken
- ✓ Talmudic tradition says Josiah hid Ark "in its place" beneath woodshed (Encyclopedia Judaica)

Jeremiah hid Ark on Mt. Nebo


During 2nd Temple – No Ark!

Well ... you know why no one knows.

God has already told us where?

Revelation 11:16-19 - Twenty-four elders ... fell on their faces and worshiped God saying:

"We give thanks to you, Lord God Almighty,

the One who is and who was, because you have taken your great power and have begun to reign.... ¹⁸The time has come for judging the dead, and for rewarding ... your people who revere your name... both great and small—and for destroying those who destroy the earth."

19 Then God's Temple in heaven was opened, and within his temple was seen the Ark of His Covenant.

And there came flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, an earthquake and a severe hailstorm.

Woe Unto Israel x TWO

4:6-8 – Ark arrives ... Israel "happy, happy, happy" ... Philistines afraid

Philistines said, "A god has come into the camp, Oh no! Nothing like this has happened before. We're doomed! Who will deliver us from the hand of these mighty gods? They are the gods who struck the Egyptians with all kinds of plagues in the wilderness."

Notice the NEWS of the Egyptian Exodus - Even Philistines KNOW

- 4:9 Mr. Motivator: "Be strong, Philistines! Be men, or you will be subject to the Hebrews, as they have been to you. Be men, and fight!"
- 4:10 Philistines kill 30,000!
- 4:11 The Ark of God captured, and Eli's two sons die.

4:12-13 – Benjamite RAN to Shiloh, tells all – "Whole town sent up a cry."

about 25 miles ... first Marathon, only to deliver news of defeat

4:14-18 Blind Eli, 98 yrs old, "What's the meaning of this uproar?"

Benjamite tells Eli all ... also that his sons are dead.


Eli fell backward off his chair, broke his neck and died – 40 years he judged Israel

4:19-22 – Eli's daughter-in-law, wife of Phinehas, dies giving birth, but is able to name baby boy Ichabod, saying,

"The Glory has departed from Israel."


NOT evident, but certain


- Philistines attack, level Shiloh
- No more from Shiloh as priests flee with Tabernacle stuff
- Not mentioned again as a religious center
- Religious center at Nob perhaps near Jebus, or near (or at) Mizpah
- ✓ Then to Gibeah ...



¹ After the Philistines had captured the Ark of God, they took it from Ebenezer to Ashdod. ² Then they carried the Ark into Dagon's temple

and set it beside Dagon.

³When the people of Ashdod rose early the next day, there was Dagon, fallen on his face on the ground before the Ark of the LORD!


shocking ...

aaah ... you NEVER hear that about YHWH!




Dagon – bas-relief at Louvre

⁴ But the following morning when they rose, there was Dagon, fallen on his face on the ground before the ark of the LORD!

His head and hands had been broken off and were lying on the threshold: only his body remained.

⁵ That is why to this day neither the priests of Dagon nor any others who enter Dagon's temple at Ashdod step on the threshold.

That is ... the head and hands were CUT OFF and PLACED on the Threshold of Temple!!

Ark on Tour ... or ... Tour de Tumor ville


⁶ The LORD's hand was heavy on the people of Ashdod and its vicinity; he brought devastation on them and

afflicted them with tumors.

Language is Posterior Tumors!

No ... we do NOT want to see illustrations of Tumorville

Pagon Pown

- ✓ Dagon Fish God, body of fish with torso of a man
- ✓ Assyrio-Babylonian deity, come to Caanan, adopted by Philistines as they – Sea Peoples – assimilated into Caanan
- ✓ Main Temples at Ashdod and Gath
- ✓ Beth-Dagon = House of Dagon, other names in O.T.
- ✓ Fertility God of sorts, fish multiply, idea of giver of all good
- ✓ Going to see others, like Baals and Astartes, i.e., gods and godesses



- ✓ ISIS destroys ancient Assyrian statues in Mosul Museum





What do YOU think?


Important ... because we are sooo removed

- without Christ, no one, NONE, get to heaven


Idols are not merely funny. To us—they're STUPID!



- 5:10 to Ekron, but people had read the newspapers NO, NO, NO Twitter Tweets ... Instagram Shots ... Facebook Videos NO, Not HERE
- 5:11 Tumorville Convention aaahh send the thing BACK!
 5:12 "Outcry went up to heaven."
- 6:1 Ark in Philistia 7 months their priests said: send it back with offering of 5 gold rats and 5 gold tumors

Cows to Beth Shemesh - Mooo ... Whew!

People of Beth Shemesh were harvesting their wheat looked up and saw the ark ... they rejoiced at the sight.

Cart came to the field of Joshua of Beth Shemesh ... stopped beside a large rock....

15 The Levites took down the ark of the LORD ... placed them on the Large Rock.

people of Beth Shemesh offered burnt offerings and made sacrifices to the LORD.

16 FIVE Rulers of the Philistines saw all this and then returned that same day to Ekron.





Rest of the Story . . . Beth Shemesh NOT Ready

- 6:17-18 Recap of Five Fortified cities of Philistia
 Ashdod, Ashkelon, Gaza, Gath and Ekron
 - The large rock on which the Levites set the Ark of the LORD is a witness to this day in the field of Joshua of Beth Shemesh.
- ¹⁹ God struck down some of the inhabitants of Beth Shemesh, putting 70 to death because they looked into the Ark of the LORD....
- People of Beth Shemesh asked, "Who can stand in the presence of the LORD, this holy God? To whom will the ark go up from here?"
- 21 They sent messengers to Kiriath Jearim, saying, "The Philistines have returned the Ark of the LORD. Come down and take it up to your town."

Kiriath Jearim Comes and Helps

7:1-17 – Men of Kiriath Jearim came, took the Ark of the LORD.

Brought it to Abinadab's house and consecrated Eleazar his son to guard the ark of the LORD.

² Ark remained at Kiriath Jearim a long time—20 years in all.

Then all the people of Israel turned back to the LORD.

³ Samuel said to Israelites, "If you are returning to the LORD with all your hearts, then rid yourselves of the foreign gods and the Ashtoreths and commit yourselves to the LORD and serve him only, and he will deliver you out of the hand of the Philistines."

4-6 Israelites did and Samuel blessed them.

Now Samuel was serving as leader of Israel at Mizpah.

Philistines Attack ... God Saved

7:7-11 – Philistines attack – Israel had assembled at Mizpah

Israelites afraid ... but Samuel said, "Do not stop crying out to the LORD ... that he may rescue us from the hand of the Philistines."

⁹ Samuel sacrifices a lamb and cries out to the LORD

and the LORD answered him.

- ¹⁰ While sacrificing ... Philistines drew near ... the LORD thundered against the Philistines and threw them into a panic....
- ¹¹ Men of Israel rushed out of Mizpah and pursued the Philistines, slaughtering them along the way to a point below Beth Kar.
- ¹² Samuel set up a stone between Mizpah and Shen, named it Ebenezer, saying, "Thus far the LORD has helped us."

Philistines Subdued

7:13-17 – Philistines were subdued and stopped invading Israel's territory.

Throughout Samuel's lifetime, hand of the LORD against Philistines.

14 Towns from Ekron to Gath were restored to Israel ...


Israel delivered the neighboring territory ...

Peace between Israel and the Amorites.

Philistines Subdued

- ¹⁵ Samuel continued as Israel's leader all the days of his life.
- From year to year he went on a circuit from Bethel to Gilgal to Mizpah, judging Israel in all those places.
- 17 But he always went back to Ramah, where his home was, and there he also held court for Israel.

He built an altar there to the LORD.





Don't Lose the Ark ... Again

Ark Represented the Divine Presence of God despite the large Christian Church

- ✓ MANY today see religion as useless, or, at best, tradition
- ✓ Vladimir Lenin Religion retards human development, led to Bolshevik Revolution 1917 – led to Stalinism
- ✓ Russian Communism spreads to China ...

 utterly atheistic, anti-God ... no small influence today
- ✓ To many "socialists" RELIGION & Christianity are foolishness

Don't Lose the Ark ... Again

Ark Represented the Divine Presence of God despite the large Christian Church

- ✓ Tooo MANY today see religion useless, or, at best, tradition
- ✓ Charles Darwin's Voyage of the Beagle 1832 and his
 Origin of the Species 1859 = EVOLUTION today's SCIENCE
- ✓ Albert Einstein's Special/General Theories of Relativity 1909 discovered (?) "time" to be RELATIVE to speed (??) ... sooo ... TIME can be manipulated, changed!
- Stephen Hawking's Quantum Mechanics 1975-present approaches a unified belief that WE can create life

Many today see Christianity as little more

than ... wait for it ... Tales of Mother Goose

Much like we see Dagon ...

Some see Christianity as Unreal

Secularists see Christianity NO different than Buddhism, Taoism ... Islam ... Goosey

Ark Represented the Divine Presence of God in Israel 1000+ yrs before Christ



The Ark Pointed to Christ

Christians have God in Their Hearts through Faith in Christ in an often Dark World

Everything Today Seems to Conspire to Steal the Ark to Steal away the Presence of God
