

# 12:1-11 Samuel's One-Two Punch—Integrity v. History

#### **ONE Punch** – Samuel's Integrity

<sup>1</sup> Samuel – "I have listened ... and set a king over you.

How important is LISTENING in God's Kingdom?

- <sup>2</sup> Now you have a king... I am old, gray, and ... leader from my youth.
- <sup>3</sup> Here I stand. Testify against me in the presence of the LORD and his anointed. Whose ox ... donkey...? Whom have I cheated? ... or taken a bribe to make me shut my eyes?
- 4 "You have not cheated or oppressed us," they replied. "You have not taken anything from anyone's hand."
- <sup>5</sup> Samuel said, "The LORD is witness against you, and his anointed is witness this day, that you have not found anything in my hand."
- "He (Saul) is witness," they said.

12:1-11 Samuel's One-Two Punch—Integrity v. History **ONE Punch** – Samuel's Integrity In so many ways, what did Samuel say? I was as honorable as I could be! I kept my vows and oaths to God—every one! I kept my oath and word to you—every one! After all these decades, if there is ONE to accuse me—step forward NOW!

Then Samuel turns to Israel

I'll tell you - Oh Israel - what YOU did

# 12:1-11 Samuel's One-Two Punch—Integrity v. History TWO Punch - Their History

- <sup>6</sup> Samuel "LORD appointed Moses and Aaron ... up out of Egypt.
- <sup>7</sup> Now ... I confront you with evidence before the LORD as to all the righteous acts performed by the LORD for you and your ancestors.
- 8 "Jacob entered Egypt, they cried to the LORD for help, and the LORD sent Moses and Aaron ... out of Egypt and settled ...
- <sup>9</sup> "They forgot the LORD ... Hazor ... Philistines ... king of Moab.

#### You - Oh Israel - FAILED to keep your word, your oath!

- <sup>10</sup> Cried out to the LORD, 'We have sinned; we have forsaken the LORD and served the Baals and the Ashtoreths.... Deliver us ....
- <sup>11</sup>Then the LORD sent Jerub-Baal (Gideon), Barak, Jephthah and Samuel ... delivered you from your enemies, so that you lived in safety.


Seems it was at Gilgal right after celebration

Samuel sacrificed at Gilgal after Shiloh destroyed



#### **Gilgal**

Gilgal – Northeast of Jericho

Joshua 4:7 "flow of the Jordan was cut off before the ark of the covenant of the LORD"

Joshua 4:20 – Joshua set up 12 stones to mark where they crossed Jordan

4:14 – That day the LORD exalted Joshua in the sight of all Israel; they stood in awe of him all the days of his life, just as they had stood in awe of Moses.

2 Kings 2:1 – When the LORD was about to take Elijah up to heaven in a whirlwind, Elijah and Elisha were on their way *from* Gilgal.

(on way to Bethel)







#### History Lesson Continues on Gilgal

Follow the Lord or ELSE!

<sup>12:12</sup> "But when you saw that Nahash king of the Ammonites was moving against you, you said to me, 'No, we want a king to rule over us'—even though the LORD your God was your king.

#### **What?...**

### Even though the Lord your God was your king!

Goodness ... how painful it must have been for Samuel to say that!

Have you had to say something painful?

Just because it HAD to be said?

#### History Lesson Continues

Follow the Lord or ELSE!

Now here is the king you have chosen, the one you asked for; see, the LORD has set a king over you.

<sup>14</sup> If you fear the LORD and serve and obey him and do not rebel against his commands, and if both you and the king who reigns over you follow the LORD your God—good!

<sup>15</sup> But if you do not obey the LORD, and if you rebel against his commands, his hand will be against you, as it was against your ancestors.

# Covenant Revisited

Mutual Agreeme.

Joshua 24 – Compare to Joshua's farewell at Shechem, dying at 110 yrs

<sup>24:25</sup> On that day Joshua made a covenant for the people, ... reaffirmed for them decrees and laws.

<sup>24:26</sup> Joshua recorded these in the Book of the Law of God. Then he took a large stone and set it up there under the oak near the holy place of the LORD.

#### **Covenant Characteristics**

- ✓ Review of History of Abraham and Moses to present
- ✓ Obligation to Yahweh
- ✓ Blessings and Curses
- √ Sign of some kind

- **Ü SOME** say 1 Samuel 12 NOT a covenant renewal, but similar and more like Samuel justifying his actions
- **ü** My opinion, don't have to use "covenant" for a "covenant" to exist
- ü Here ... let's shake on it!!!

### **Covenants of Past**

#### Keeping One's Word in 1000 B.C.

Origins of word "Covenant" – not certain, but likely "fetter" or "binding"

- Confirmed with an oath
- Confirmed with a solemn meal
- ✓ Confirmed with a sacrifice

#### Various Types of Covenants

- ✓ Between individuals
- ✓ Between states
- ✓ Between kings & subjects
- ✓ Between husband & wife
- ✓ Figuratively between men & animals

#### **Not always a Mutual Covenant**

Between powerful & inferior, as one taking another under protection as Ammon wanted with Jabesh Gilead

Saul fixed Ammon in battle from night to mid-day ... and was confirmed king



# Covenants of Today

We make many oaths or "covenants" today

### **Our Church Covenant**

Preamble: Church Covenant is our voluntary agreement to conduct our lives to glorify and promote the ongoing ministry of our Lord Jesus Christ. The covenant outlines the obligations of Christian character of church unity and family.

We probably have one posted somewhere ... 1 page with 10-14 mutual commitments

Saw in a Google search one Independent Baptist Church's was 77 pages long ... haha ... nuts

Keeping One's Word in 1000 B.C.

#### Between God and Israel –

- ✓ Exodus 19-24 at Mt. Sinai
- ✓ Deuteronomy Entire Book!

#### Between God and Abraham -

Gen. 15 - Promise Land to Israel

Gen. 17 - Father of Many Nations

#### **Between God and David**

II Sam. 7 - House Endure Forever

God's Covenants with Israel were OBLIGATORY

must keep obligation to receive

God's Covenants to Abraham and David are PROMISARY obligation not required to receive No Limit ... No Expiration

UNCONDITIONAL

Like our Salvation in Christ – Born Again is *ETERNAL*

#### Rain & Thunder on Call

<sup>16</sup> "Now then, stand still and see this great thing the LORD is about to do before your eyes!

Is it not wheat harvest now?
I will call on the LORD to send thunder and rain.

And you will realize what an evil thing you did in the eyes of the LORD when you asked for a king."


Vicious rain will damage harvest, even destroy ... lead to famine!

#### Rain & Thunder on Call

<sup>17</sup> Is it not wheat harvest now? I will call on the LORD to send thunder and rain. And you will realize what an evil thing you did in the eyes of the LORD when you asked for a king."

18 Then Samuel called on the LORD, and that same day the LORD sent

thunder and rain.

# Miracle

So all the people stood in awe of the LORD and of Samuel.

#### **Lord Will Not Reject**

<sup>19</sup> The people all said to Samuel, "Pray to the LORD your God for your servants so that we will not die, for we have added to all our other sins the evil of asking for a king."

<sup>20</sup> "Do not be afraid," Samuel replied. "You have done all this evil; yet do not turn away from the LORD, but serve the LORD with all your heart.

<sup>21</sup> Do not turn away after useless idols. They can do you no good, nor can they rescue you, because they are useless.

<sup>22</sup> For the sake of his great name the LORD will not reject his people, because the LORD was pleased to make you his own.



#### UNCONDITIONAL

Covenant in 1100 B.C. ... keeping one's word we have trouble to see too ...

Remember the story of Jephthah?

His covenant, his promise – he'll sacrifice first thing he sees on return ... what?

#### **His Daughter Appears!!!!!**

Keeping his "Obligation" striking to us

But what is MUCH MORE striking is his daughter's PERFECT understanding and HER courage to face it


Jephthah and his daughter

Jephthah's KEEPING his word is strange to us ... because of ?????

Because we understand LOVE much better than he did ... N.T. LOVE

NOT that he loved his daughter LESS, for he did NOT love LESS

Jephthah had a value of OATH we DON'T have—we see him as psychotic

We know LOVE as self-sacrificing in a way that he did NOT

What is MORE remarkable in his "obligation" and INFORMS to us today ...

### His Daughter's Perfect Understanding

That she ACCEPTED it tells us VOLUMES

ALL knew BACK THEN a Promise to God is KEPT even more valuable than life itself

### PAUSE

Jephthah's Oath – why here on Samuel's retirement? Oath and Idols - side by side - FAR from us TODAY Samuel Hated Idols and KEPT HIS OATH to God in a way we have trouble grappling with today Israel then in 1000 B.C. knew how terribly wrong terribly wrong they were TIME and TIME AGAIN in how they COULD NOT KEEP their Oath to God

## 12:19-22 God's Mercy and Grace Lord Will Not Reject – UNCONDITIONAL

Ooooh ... let me explain

We dig deeper to understand Jephthah's Oath?

And therefore understand MORE of Samuel's Faith?

ALL of us here are men and women who keep our word ... I do NOT question that

Likewise, I KNOW – sure as the sunshine – NO ONE among us, not a single one, would kill our son or daughter for anything, much less a misspoken oath!

Let me bring this home ... then we'll close

## 12:19-22 God's Mercy and Grace NEWS BRIEF

ISIS soldiers heard a mother threaten her stubborn 10-year-old daughter

If her daughter did not obey, the mother said, "I'll behead you, swear to God"

Daughter disobeyed ... soldiers told mother to behead daughter – she did not.

Mother was GOING to KEEP her word to God!

So, ISIS soldiers beheaded the 10-yr old daughter FOR the mother

They made her HOLD her beheaded daughter!

Today – we cannot understand "idols" NOR a "vow" "obligation" like Jephthah's or ISIS'

ISIS' vows are clearly Satanic ... murderous

Jephthah's vow was to God ... before the N.T.

No ...
I'd NEVER show anything like that

God knows ... I wish
I had NOT seen it

- ✓ Only ONE reason an Oath is chosen over innocent life
- ✓ When YOU are asked to deny Christ you ought to die first ... hope we never have to
- ✓ Today, our N.T. value of Love cherishes the Sanctity of Life

<sup>23</sup> As for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the LORD by failing to pray for you. I will teach you the way that is good and right.

<sup>24</sup> But be sure to fear the LORD and serve him faithfully with all your heart;

<sup>25</sup> Yet if you persist in doing evil, both you and your king will perish."

Covenant Renewal summary is Clear as a button ...


Keep your word to serve God ... or else

In my book, Would You Lie to Save Life?
I detail how the absolutes of Love and Truth relate
In 1968 Com. Bucher saved the lives of his men with a lie.

- ✓ Love found a way to a respectable choice.
- ✓ Gold standard is that we can always Love.
- ✓ Love—best served on the plate of freedom.
- ✓ Love—the sum of virtues and treasure of trust.
- ✓ No dilemma where we would not choose Love.
- ✓ Love found a way to top the available options.

Fear the Lord = LOVE the Lord consider what great things he has done for you.

Samuel LOVED his people ... served them ALL his life

### 12:23-25 Samuel Prays, Teaches - Fear the Lord

Fear the Lord = LOVE the Lord consider what great things he has done for you.

Samuel KNEW ... he knew more than all what he was leaving behind

He would REMAIN as their Prophet ...
remain as their WISE MAN

Samuel LOVED his people, deeply, though he and they had NOT the words yet

They knew NOT the LOVE we know today

He'd remain their beloved, loved, even adored and respected National Grandpa

Perhaps, as Samuel left Gilgal on his way to his home in Ramah, he felt this way ...
