2 Kings 18 – Ahaz's son Hezekiah reigns in Jerusalem of Judah 29 years

18:3 "He did what was right in the Eyes of the Lord, just as his father David had done.

18:5 Hezekiah trusted in the Lord, the God of Israel. There was no one like him among all the kings of Judah, either before him or after him.

2 Kings 18 recaps Shalmaneser's conquest of Israel & taking of Samaria



2 Kings 18 – Shalmaneser dies Assyria's Sennacherib invades MORE

"I have done wrong. Withdraw from me, and I will pay whatever you demand of me."

Many believe 3 names are TITLES

For instance ... in Jeremiah 39:3

"Nebo-Sarsekim a Chief Officer" (Tartan)

Rabshakeh is the multi-lingual Chief Speaker

In Hebrew, he mocks Judah's God and Hezekiah's faith





18:17 aqueduct of the Upper Pool, on the road to the Washerman's Field

Refers to a place hidden from Assyrians

Hezekiah's Tunnel is famous today

Began at the Gihon Spring, was carved from two places

When tunnellers met after 586 yards only about a foot of difference

Let's take a stroll through it








Hezekiah's Tunnel

Hezekiah's men seem woefully ignorant




2 Kings 19 ... Hezekiah PRAYS



- 16 Give ear ... open your eyes, Lord, see; listen to the words Sennacherib has sent to ridicule the living God....
- 19 Now, Lord our God, deliver us ... so that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that you alone, Lord, are God."


2 Kings 19: 21-34 ... Mighty Isaiah sends God's response to Hezekiah

Virgin Daughter Zion despises you and mocks you.

Daughter Jerusalem tosses her head as you flee.

22 Who is it you have ridiculed and blasphemed?
Against whom have you lifted your eyes in pride?

Against the Holy One of Israel!

See Isaiah's exquisite words in 2 Kings 19:20–37



- ¹ In those days Hezekiah became ill and was at the point of death. The prophet Isaiah son of Amoz went to him and said,
- "This is what the Lord says: Put your house in order, because you are going to die; you will not recover."
- ²Hezekiah turned his face to the wall and prayed to the Lord, ³ "Remember, Lord, how I have walked before you faithfully and with wholehearted devotion and have done what is good in your eyes." And Hezekiah wept bitterly.

4 Before Isaiah had left the middle court, the word of the Lord came to him:

⁵ "Go back and tell Hezekiah, the ruler of my people, 'This is what the Lord, the God of your father David, says:

I have heard your prayer and seen your tears; I will heal you. On the 3rd day you will go up to the temple of the Lord.

⁶ I will add 15 years to your life. And I will deliver you and this city from the hand of the king of Assyria. I will defend this city for my sake and for the sake of my servant David."

⁷Then Isaiah said, "Prepare a poultice of figs." They did so and applied it to the boil, and he recovered.

⁸ Hezekiah had asked Isaiah, "What will be the sign that the Lord will heal me and that I will go up to the temple of the Lord on the 3rd day from now?"

⁹ Isaiah answered, "This is the Lord's sign to you that the Lord will do what he has promised: Shall the shadow go forward ten steps, or shall it go back ten steps?"

¹⁰ "It is a simple matter for the shadow to go forward ten steps," said Hezekiah. "Rather, have it go back ten steps."

¹¹ Then the prophet Isaiah called on the Lord, and the Lord made the shadow go back the ten steps it had gone down on the stairway of Ahaz.


God's Foreknowledge: Exhaustive & Settled ... or NOT
