

2 Kings 20:20 – Hezekiah dies ... See Book of Annals of the Kings of Judah

2 Kings 21 ... Manasseh reigns 55 yrs Does Evil ...

Rebuilt altars to Baal ... etc

2 Kings 21 ... Amon reigns 2 yrs

Does Evil ...

For both—their deeds are recorded in Book of Annals of the Kings of Judah



2 Kings 22 Josiah reigns 31 years in his 18th year ... his people FIND Book of the Covenant in the Temple

Prophetess Huldah Consulted

Josiah comes to the throne 8 years old 2 Chron 34 ADDS info on 12th year Josiah PURGES Land of Idols

2 Kgs 22:8 - 18th Year PURGES Temple
Sends Shaphan his secretary / Chief of Staff
to look after things



2 Kings 22 High Priest Hilkiah FOUND Book of the Law in Temple Gave it to Shaphan, who read it

Money is being paid to workers, etc

Shaphan reports to Josiah

AND LOOKY LOOKY ... at this BOOK

When Josiah hears ... tears robe

You See This ODD too

Clear as the blue sky—How Long had Book of Law been *HIDDEN*?



2 Kings 22 Josiah ORDERS Hilkiah, Hilkiah's son Ahikam, Akbor, Shaphan, and Asaiah

Go, inquire of the Lord for me, the people, all of Judah about what is Written in this book that was found. **Great is the Lord's anger that burns** against us because those who have gone before us have not obeyed the words of this book....

Notice HERE ... Josiah isn't playing **No GAMES** Josiah is ASKING for ALL ... for himself for the people **ALL of Judah** 

Josiah sincerely wants TRUTH

2 Kings 22 Hilkiah & son Ahikam, Akbor, Shaphan, & Asaiah ... go

Listen closely to this precious passage

went to speak to the prophet Huldah ...

wife of Shallum ... keeper of the wardrobe.

She lived in Jerusalem ... New Quarter.

SEE what's happened here?

When ORDERED to inquire of the LORD King's Secretary & High Priest

#### **FIVE Prophetesses in OT**

Huldah (weasel) wife of Shallum 2 Kings 22:14 & 2 Chron 34:22

Miriam (of sea or bitter) Moses/Aaron's sister Exodus 15:20

Deborah (bee or wasp) wife of Lappidoth Judges 4:4

**Noadiah** (tryst of Yah) with other prophets tried to "intimidate" Nehemiah Nehemiah 6:14

Unnamed prophetess bore Isaiah's 2nd son Isaiah 8:3 ... his wife – hang onto that thought




Prophet בְיא, nabi = masculine 316x in O.T. in 36 varieties Masculine used in 1 Kings 18, for both Elijah & plural Prophets of Baal

*Prophetess* נְבִיאָה *nebiah* = feminine 5x ... 1x as han-nabiah

C.B. Reynolds makes case Isaiah's wife was prophetess *before* Isaiah's call

Isaiah's 1st son in Isa. 7 NOT a baby was named *before* Isaiah's commission



Isaiah calls her such & other prophets call theirs "wife"

# MINIMIZING by MEN Scholars Online Jewish Encyclopedia says King Josiah

"addressed her, and not Jeremiah, because he thought women are more easily stirred to pity than men, and "therefore, the prophetess would be more likely than Jeremiah to intercede with God in his behalf"



Encyclopedia Judaica says similar Apparently, Cyclopedia folk never met Judge Judy

Jehoahaz, Jehoiakim, Jehoiachin did EVIL




2 Kings 24 Jehoiachin vassal of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon Jehoiachin's WEAK 3-month reign ...
Nebuchadnezzar comes to Jerusalem everyone surrenders ...


Nebuchadnezzar loots temple & takes Jehoiachin, family, nobles prisoners

That is—BEST / LAST Revival in Israel's history


**BEGAN** with the Prophetess Huldah

- **✓** ONLY & TOP prophet available
- ✓ ONLY one KNEW what God wanted
- ✓ ONLY one KNEW meaning of the Book of the Law

This has PROFOUND importance for Meaning of Women in Ministry




Stop, Look, Listen to 2 Kings 22 ... read the chapter

Bakery ... Jeweler


Homes of quarry workers
