





Reminds them ... yes ... Peter will REMIND them ...

However, notice ... look and see ...

The beloved Christians in Asia Minor and Galatia were GOOD

They were ESTABLISHED ... in the TRUTH

Critical to this whole letter ... these were NOT children

- These were NOT ignorant
- These were LOVED and STUDIOUS
- These were LOVED and LEARNED and ESTABLISHED disciples

- ¹² Therefore I will always remind you about these things, even though you know them and are established in the truth you have.
 - LOVED and LEARNED and ESTABLISHED
 - ✓ Like us, here at FBC Woodville
 - Thank God for our fellowship
 - Thank God for our Living Hope

- ¹³ I consider it right, as long as I am in this bodily tent, to wake you up with a reminder, ¹⁴knowing that I will soon <u>lay aside my tent,</u> as our Lord Jesus Christ has also shown me. ¹⁵And I will also make every effort that you may be able to recall these things at any time after my departure.
- In 2 Peter 3:15-16, Peter said he's read St. Paul's "letters" though, "There are some things in them that are hard to understand
- LOVE Peter ... some in Paul "hard to understand"—yeah!
- 2 Cor. 5:8, NIV, Paul said, "We are confident, I say, and would prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord."
- KJV, New Living, ESV, Berean, Douay-Rheims, Darby, NAS, ASV, "rather be away/absent from these earthly bodies, for then we will be at home/present with the Lord."

- ¹³ I consider it right, as long as I am in this bodily tent, to wake you up with a reminder, ¹⁴knowing that I will soon <u>lay aside my tent</u>, as our Lord Jesus Christ has also shown me. ¹⁵And I will also make every effort that you may be able to recall these things at any time after my departure.
- "Mirror, Mirror on the wall, who is the fairest of all?" asked the Evil Queen in Snow White ...
- Magic Mirror CANNOT lie ... Evil Queen was fairest until Snow White grew a little
- I have NEWS for you ... good news ...
- Who you are as a person ...
 - is NOT necessarily who you see in the mirror



Jesus said now FAMOUS words to one thief on a cross "TODAY you will be with me in Paradise" We not only age, but LIFE happens and ... We get scarred by this and that ... Sometimes we get BURNED ... badly ... By accident or by traitor ... some lose their nose an arm ... a leg ... Oh, "Mirror, mirror on the wall ..." - sometimes I do NOT like you ... you truth-telling beast! But, one day, I shall be with HIM in Paradise This TENT will be gone ... I shall be clothed immortal





YOU For we ALL shall put OFF this TENT one day Peter Made whole and new ... risen up YOU The corrupted will put on the incorruptible Christian This mortal tent GONE are the This mortal shall put on *immortality* FAIREST Peter KNOWS ... his TENT is NOT that important our TENT is NOT that important

- Peter shall LAY ASIDE his TENT as his and our Lord Jesus Christ had shown him
- What shall Peter say ?????
- What is the MOST IMPORTANT thing he can give? Peter shall give his Christian Family an ANCHOR Something that CANNOT FALTER in the storm

2 Peter 1:16-18 Eyewitnesses – Saw His Majestic Glory

Stupendous words ... Peter gives them so gently **HIGH words ... Peter tenders to them as though** there were his own family and children even as they were *dear* his brothers & sisters! Words higher than ALL the mountains ... Peter had a LOT of credentials in his resume Peter – had walked on water and healed the lame Peter – witnessed crucifixion Peter – saw miracles, was made an APOSTLE Peter – beaten, jailed, freed by an angel Peter had a FULL résumé

2 Peter 1:16-18 Eyewitnesses – Saw His Majestic Glory

- For his Last Farewell ... Peter pulls out the big guns Of many great things on his resume, one is HIGHEST
- To his dearly beloved, Peter gives his best
- ¹⁶ For we did not follow cleverly contrived myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ; instead, we were eyewitnesses of His majesty.
- ¹⁷For when He received honor and glory from God the Father, a voice came to Him from the Majestic Glory:

This is My beloved Son. I take delight in Him!

¹⁸ And we heard this voice when it came from heaven while we were with Him on the holy mountain. **2 Peter 1:16-18 Eyewitnesses – Saw His Majestic Glory** Peter's highest point ... the **Transfiguration!** He got to see Jesus RECEIVE Honor and Glory from GOD God the Father, the Creator ... he the eyewitness Peter, James and John ... saw Jesus with Moses and Elijan Some say, this CERTIFIED Jesus' fulfillment of both ➢ Law … represented in Moses Prophecy ... represented in Elijah Only Peter notes that Jesus received "honor and glory" Only Peter called God the "Majestic Glory" More than a TOP resume item—only three on earth This was an EXPERIENCE ... an EVENT

2 Peter 1:16-18 Eyewitnesses – Saw His Majestic Glory

Peter, James and John got to SEE Christ's glory Before the Resurrection ... a GLORY bestowed upon Christ Then they HEARD the voice of God ... This is My beloved Son. I take delight in Him! For Peter, James and John ... like the Apostle Paul later This was a SHOCKING event ... undeniable Life-changing event ... YOU NEVER FORGET Far from bragging, Peter has a REASON for sharing These ESTABLISHED beloved Christians **NEED a solid ETERNAL anchor ...**

- Peter gives them an anchor to life—the Word of God CONFIRMED
- **ESTABLISHED Christians should be MADE IMPREGNABLE**
- Of all the contraries in life—God's Word is TRUTH
 - God's Word Reliable—God's Word Absolutely Certain


Let all men be liars and God be TRUE

- Peter closes this section ... before slamming False Teachers explaining the fuller nature of prophecy and Scripture
- ²⁰ First of all, you should know this: No prophecy of Scripture comes from one's own interpretation, ²¹ because no prophecy ever came by the will of man; instead, men spoke from God as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.
- Lot of ways looking this ... the essence is
 - Scripture prophecy NOT from men
 - Scripture NOT from WILL of men
 - Scripture from men MOVED by God

Another passage unique to Peter ... critical to doctrine on Bible

- ²⁰ First of all, you should know this: No prophecy of Scripture comes from one's own interpretation, ²¹ because no prophecy ever came by the will of man; instead, men spoke from God as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.
- Not from the Will of Man ... but by the Will of God MOVING Men
- Term "moved" is as the wind "moves" along a ship on the
- Kindred Scripture on itself are scattered throughout
- 2 Tim. 3:16-17, All Scripture is God-breathed ... useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

How do you interpret the Bible?


- ✓ All is from God … original autographs "right"

- ✓ No passage will ultimately conflict with another
- Beloved Christians were established ... yet, sadly, persecution was happening ... killing Christians ...

How do you make a choice when the Absolutely "Right" Choice eludes you?

Peter says: "Pay attention to the God's CONFIRMED Word"

then ✓ Seek First the Kingdom of God

Do unto others as you would have done to you, etc.





6. Love's 1st Foundation—Simplicity

Love is simple. One does *not* need schooling to enjoy Love's best riches, and at times schooling will distract from Love.


The very moment you turn from Loving to the analysis of Love, like from the viewing of Mt. Everest to the analysis of the rock, you loose some perspective. Analysis of life is complex, but not so much the LIVING of LIFE; we cannot enjoy the majesty ... the infinity of moods of Mt. Everest and analyze the rock at the same time.

Love – and Scripture ... a simplicity

Think of walking down the street whistling

SKILL in walking we NATURALLY enjoy

Explain physics & biology—we might chock on our whistle

Perhaps Love is like the ocean, full of conflict, full of pain, Like a fire when it's cold outside, thunder when it rains....






Perhaps Love – by John Denver continued

9. Love's 4th Foundation in TIME


- ✓ Since every choice comes from a UNIQUE person and every situation is UNIQUE—Every choice is UNIQUE
- Every CHOICE involves the FUTURE ...
- ✓ In order to "Seek First the Kingdom" & "Do unto Others" each of us MUST consider the FUTURE consequences
- ✓ Therefore, SOME (?)—SOME—"Consideration of the future" will determine SOME of the "RIGHTNESS" of the choice

 - You will DO WELL to PAY ATTENTION TO IT, as to a LAMP shining in a dismal place, until the day dawns and the Morning Star rises in your hearts.
- Pay ATTENTION to the impregnable, irrefutable Word of God
- Just as 2 Timothy 2:15 says
- Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

No greater wish has Peter ...

No greater encouragement ... than to

Anchor ALL to the Word of God

- You will do well to pay attention to it, as to a lamp shining in a dismal place, until the day dawns and the Morning Star rises in your hearts. Thus anchored ... with a Living Hope ... **Until the Morning Star Rises in your Hearts** Morning Star ... from which we get our word "phosphorus" Morning Star ... the light that DAWNS after darkness Morning Star ... the night runs away as the sun rises Morning Star ... dark, hopeless soul brightens as the SON rises
- Morning Star ... the SON, the LIGHT of the World ...
- Morning Star ... on the last day, Christ Returns ... first in our hearts
