

5:1-5 All Came to 30-yr-old David vs. 4, David 30 years old ... reigned 40 years

In Hebron he reigned over Judah 7.5 years, and in Jerusalem he reigned over ALL Israel & Judah 33 years.



Whoever wrote this ... wrote it well after the events

David is a Young man ... boat load of wilderness experience

Load of Experience Leading Men

May NOT Have ALWAYS Trusted Each Other

But They TRUSTED David

5:6-8 David Takes Jerusalem ... Via Water Shaft

If you recall from Judges, the City of Jebus was one of the cities Joshua could NOT take

Jebus is already an OLD Fortification

Jebusites MOCK David ... saying

6 ... "even the blind & lame can ward you off!"

David turns their mockery around ... to his men

8 whoever takes it will have to use the water shaft ...
why they say the blind & lame will not enter the palace

Jebusites UNDERESTIMATE King David



Warren's Shaft Discovered in 1867

by Sir Charles Warren (1840–1927).

Runs from within the old city to near the Gihon Spring

Don't confuse it with Hezekiah's tunnel built 300 yrs later to the Pool of Siloam

1 Chronicles 11 tells us the rest of the story ...



1 Chronicles 11:1-9 – Taking Jerusalem

Pretty much the same as 2 Samuel 5

Except verse 6 tells how Joab became Commander:

⁶ David said, "Whoever leads the attack on the Jebusites will become commander-in-chief."

Joab son of Zeruiah went up first, and so he received the command.

Chronicles 11:10-47 ... 37 verses tell us at length of David's

Mighty Men



2 Samuel 5 – Taking of Jebus - Jerusalem



5:9-12 Recognized –
David Builds Jerusalem & Palace Philistine

⁹ David then took up residence in the fortress and called it the City of David.

He built up the area around it, from the terraces inward.

¹⁰ And he became more and more powerful, *because*

the LORD God Almighty was with him.



¹¹ Hiram king of Tyre sent envoys to David, along with cedar logs and carpenters and stonemasons, and they built a palace for David.

12 Then David knew that the LORD had established him as king over Israel and had exalted his kingdom for the sake of his people Israel.



2 Sam. 5:13-16 Moves FULLY to Jerusalem ...

More Wives & Porcupines ... some sons listed

5:17-25, Twice Routes Philistines in Valley of Rephaim

On the second time David inquires of the LORD God says to circle around and

²³ ... attack them in front of the POPLAR TREES.

²⁴ As soon as you hear the sound of marching in the tops of the POPLAR TREES, move quickly, because that will mean the LORD has gone out in front of you to strike the Philistine army."





The KJV has a beautiful version of verse 24

24 And let it be, when thou hearest the sound of a going in the tops of the

Mulberry Trees

that then thou shalt bestir thyself: for then shall the LORD go out before, thee to smite the host of the Philistines.

Oh ... the wind in the trees ... to fight the enemy God in the Wind of the Mulberry Trees

David beats them back ... CLEARING the way for a

6:1-12 Ark from Baalah to Obed-Edom's House ... to Jerusalem

David takes 30,000 young men with him & goes to Baalah in Judah to the House of Abinadab – on a hill


6:5, David assembled all Israel, from the Shihor River in Egypt to Lebo Hamath, to bring the ark of God from



Ark of the Covenant

Who, What, Where

Ex. 25:10-22 & 37:1-9

- ✓ Moses given specs on Mt. Sinai
- ✓ Ark made by Bezalel to specs 4'2" long x 30" high
- Made of acacia overlaid in gold
- ✓ Two angels faced each other
- ✓ Same from Exodus to Temple
- ✓ Temple of Solomon, two huge angels stand on each side made of olive wood overlaid in gold



Placed inside Tabernacle inside the Holy of Holies

Carried for 40 Years in Wilderness
Carried during Conquest
Went before Joshua at Jericho
Resided at Shiloh after Conquest



¹ After the Philistines had captured the Ark of God, they took it from Ebenezer to Ashdod. ² Then they carried the Ark into Dagon's temple

and set it beside Dagon.

AFTER Shiloh, AFTER Ebenezer

- AFTER Ark Tour of Philistia
- ✓ Goes to Beth-Shemesh then to Baalah or Kiriath-jearim for 60 yrs
- ✓ David takes from Kiriath-jearim to Obed-Edom for three months
- ✓ David puts it in tent in Jerusalem
- ✓ Then in Solomon's Temple
- ✓ Temple destroyed 586 B.C. & it not mentioned with vessels taken
- ✓ Talmudic tradition says Josiah hid Ark "in its place" beneath woodshed (Encyclopedia Judaica)




Legend in II Maccebees 2:1-7





6:1-12 Ark from Baalah to Obed-Edom's House to Jerusalem

David takes 30,000 young men with him



12 Now King David was told,

"The LORD has blessed the household of Obed-Edom and everything he has,

because of the Ark of God."

So David went to bring up the Ark of God from the house of Obed-Edom to the City of David with rejoicing.

¹³ When those who were carrying the Ark of the LORD had taken six steps, he sacrificed a bull & a fattened calf.



¹⁴ Wearing a linen ephod,

David was dancing

before the LORD with all his might,

bringing up the Ark of the LORD with shouts and the sound of trumpets.

1 Chronicles 15 ... please read ...



1 Chronicles 15 ... please read ...

David called forth the descendants of Aaron & Levites ... numbered them

Priests Zadok & Abiathar ... ____ they carry Ark on shoulders

Cymbals, Lyres, Harps playing – Trumpets Blasted

15:22: Head Levite Kenaniah in charge of the SINGING; was his responsibility because

he was skillful at it.

1 Chronicles 15 details more ...

15:27 Now David was clothed in a robe of fine linen, as were all the Levites who were carrying the ark, and as were the musicians, and Kenaniah, who was in charge of the singing of the choirs.

David also wore a LINEN EPHOD.

15:28 So all Israel brought up the

Ark of the Covenant of the LORD

with shouts ... sounding of rams' horns trumpets ... cymbals ... lyres ... harps.

Ephod in Gold under breast plate

^{1 Chron. 15:27} ... David also wore a linen ephod.

Ephod is worn by Priests ... Samuel ... and David

I Sam. 22:18, notice that 85 priests of Nob are men that "did wear a linen ephod"

Exodus 39:2, "blue & purple, of scarlet, & fine twined linen" embroidered in Gold §

Lev. 8:7, mentions Ephod OVER a Robe

like an apron ... a "mark of Holy Distinction"

David wore a Fine Robe and the Ephod ...

1 Chronicles 15:29 repeats this verse

2 Samuel 6:16:

As the Ark of the LORD was entering the City of David, Michal, the daughter of Saul, watched from a window.

When she saw King David leaping and dancing before the LORD,

she despised him in her heart.


Of all the attributes David possessed, or LEARNED He KNEW when someone DESPISED him



6:17-19 Celebrated –
Ark Set in Tent, David Fed Bread to Israel

¹⁷ They brought the ark of the LORD and set it in its place inside the tent that David had pitched for it, and David sacrificed burnt offerings and fellowship offerings before the LORD.

18 After he had finished sacrificing ... he
blessed the people
in the name of the LORD Almighty.



6:20-22 Michal Peeved at David's Dancing

²⁰ When David returned home to

bless his household,

Michal daughter of Saul met him and said,

"How the king of Israel has distinguished himself today, going around HALF-NAKED in full view of the slave girls of his servants as ANY VULGAR FELLOW WOULD!"

²¹ David said to Michal, "It was before the LORD, who chose me rather than your father or anyone from his house when he appointed me ruler over the LORD's people Israel—I will celebrate before the LORD.



^{1 Chron. 15:27} ... David also wore a linen ephod.

David wore the Ephod to Honor the Lord as Head of the Priestly Nation

Because Michal is peeved at David "HALF-NAKED"

when he entered Jerusalem

Did David remove the robe and wear the

Ephod ALONE?

God knows ...

6:20-22 Michal Peeved at David's Dancing

David responds clearly ... yet oddly ...

²² I will become even more undignified than this,

I will be humiliated in my own eyes.

But by these slave girls you spoke of, I will be held in honor."

²³ And Michal daughter of Saul had no children to the day of her death.

You know what that meant ...

She was the first of his WIVES to meet him ... yet no more

David's Psalm of Ascent 131 opens with

¹ My heart is not proud, LORD, my eyes are not haughty; I do not concern myself with great matters.... 6:20-22 Michal Peeved at David's Dancing

Near closing ... let it be noted far and wide Of all the SEXUAL CRAZINESS of 1000 B.C.

Even of the many wives and porcupines of David

Even of the insanity of Bathsheba to come

Notice this ... Michal rejects David ... & David rejects HER

But David does NOT divorce her ... does NOT beat her ...

You see ... REAL Man ... truly HONORABLE Man

Has NO Desire to have relations with a

Woman Who Does Not WANT Him
