DEUTERONOMY 12:1-26:19

14 Chapters

The context for the text of this lesson is quite large, Deuteronomy 12:1–26:19. We saw that the previous major section, 5:1–11:32, was a general set of exhortations encouraging Israel to remain faithful to God and to learn and obey all His commands. In 12:1–26:19, we have commands that are more specific, instructing the Israelites about a wide range of topics. Some particular topics are as follows (this is not an exhaustive list):



✓ Deuteronomy = 2nd Law ... Outline

- the central sanctuary (12:1-28);
 - dealing with apostates (13:1-11);
- dietary rules (14:3-21);
 - the three annual pilgrimages (16:1-1
- rules for the kings (17:14-20);
 - criminal laws (19:1-21);
- laws about conducting a war (20:1-20),
 - dealing with women taken captive in war (21:10-14);
- respect for the property rights of other people (22:1-4);
 - sexual misconduct (22:13-30);
- money loaned at interest (23:19-20);
 - marriage and divorce (24:1-5);
- charity toward widows, orphans, and resident aliens (24:19-22); and
 - a man's duty toward the widow of his deceased brother (25:5-10).

Reflection — How LITERAL? ...

- √ Verse 18:20 asks DEATH for false prophets
- ✓ Sanctity of Life? ... Based on *deduction* from 6th Commandment "Don't Murder"
- ✓ If we want to take so SERIOUS today the anti-abortion as God's LAW not to murder
- ✓ That is a Deduction FROM a Command
- ✓ Not unreasonable ... still a deduction ...

Reflection — How LITERAL? ...

- ✓ Then how SERIOUS do we take the LAW to KILL False Prophets?
- ✓ We have made the DEDUCTION more serious than the COMMAND ...
- ✓ NOT made CLEAR our own DUPLICITY
- Serious about Abortion Deduction vs.

by a Tyler County jury ... torture & murder of 64-year-old

Susan Morris of Onalaska

- Sentence: Life without parole
- Too expensive to seek DEATH
- How literal to take God's Word



Deuteronomy 18:14-17 ... The Need

14 - The nations you will dispossess listen to those who practice sorcery or divination.

But as for you, the Lord your God has NOT permitted you to do so.

What is going on today?
King Saul sought the Witch of Endor
Today every newspaper has a horoscope



Deuteronomy 18:15-17 ... The Need

15 - The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your fellow Israelites. You must listen to him.

Deut. 34:10 – Moses Greatest Prophet

Acts 3:22 – Peter preached using this passage ... pointing to Jesus

then ... Peter and John were arrested ...



Deuteronomy 18:15-17 ... The Need

- 16 For this is what you asked of the Lord your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly when you said,
 - "Let us not hear the voice of the Lord our God nor see this great fire anymore, or we will die."
- 17 Lord said to me: "What they say is good."
 Moses and Jesus spoke directly to God

Deuteronomy 18:18-19 ... The Provision

18 - I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their fellow Israelites,
I will put my words in his mouth.
He will tell them everything I command him.

Responsibility of the Prophet ...

What is the Prophet supposed to do ... ???



Deuteronomy 18:18-19 ... The Provision

19 - I myself will call to account anyone who does NOT listen to my words that the prophet speaks in my name.

God ... Himself ... will hold accountable Job of the Prophet ..<mark>. deadly serious ...</mark>



Deuteronomy 18:20-22 ... The Test

20 - But a prophet who presumes to speak in my name anything I have NOT commanded, or a prophet who speaks in the name of other gods, is to be put to DEATH."

DEATH

Who wants to apply for that job?

Get it RIGHT or DIE ... darn serious



Deuteronomy 18:20-22 ... The Test

21 - You may say to yourselves,
"How can we know when a message
has not been spoken by the Lord?"
And we do today ...
How do we know ... God's Will???



Deuteronomy 18:20-22 ... The Test

22 - If what a prophet proclaims in the name of the Lord does NOT take place or come true, that is a message the Lord has NOT spoken.

That prophet has spoken presumptuously, so do not be alarmed.

Proof ... is in fulfillment ...

We have a DUTY to follow God's commands God will provide leaders ... if we LISTEN God has given us a New Testament ... We do NOT Kill False Prophets today for many reasons Namely, Christ fulfilled the LAW ... all of it Our Duty ... today ... is ... **Love God with All our HEARTS Love Others as We Love Ourselves**
