

After 40 years of wandering & at 120 years old


We have Deuteronomy – His final words, Last Farewell



- 1:1 These are the words of Moses
- 1:6 The Lord our God said to us at Horeb,
 "You have stayed long enough at this mountain

Moses recounts trip, the selection of leaders, the trek, 12 Spies AND the Israelite's rebellion

Chapter 2 recalls 38 years of wandering

2:14 Thirty-eight years passed from the time we left Kadesh Barnea until we crossed the Zered Valley.

By then, that entire generation of fighting men had perished from the camp, as the Lord had sworn to them

- 3:1-13 Moses continues with defeat of Og & Amorites
- 3:12-20 Moses recalls in brief the Divisions of the Land
- 3:18 I commanded you at that time: "The Lord your God has given you this land to take possession"
- 3:21-28 Moses praises THEN ASKS GOD
- 3:25 Let ME GO OVER & SEE the good land beyond the Jordan—that fine hill country & Lebanon."

Moses ASKED to go!!!

God refused, with fine stern words

STILL Moses calls Israel to Love GOD TODAY

Moses gives Israel a safe Harbor—IF they shall choose Charles H. Spurgeon, Sunday, 3-12-1876 – Deut 4:29-31 When ships at sea apprehend a storm they will gladly make for an open harbour, but if the storm causes doubt,



Charles H. Spurgeon Sailors weather the tempest by Alexander Melville rather than run the risk of missing the harbour & hitting rocks.... When the welcome signals are flying & ... there is plenty of water, and that they may safely run behind the breakwater they hesitate no longer, but make sail for the shelter.

Charles H. Spurgeon, Sunday, March 12, 1876 – Deut 4:29-31 Let seeking souls know this day that the Lord's harbour of refuge is open, Port of Free Grace can be reached, there is sea room for the hugest transgressor, Charles H. Spurgeon LOVE enough to float the greatest sinner into port. by Alexander Melville Ho, weather-beaten vessels, ye may come and welcome! There is NO need that even for a solitary hour that ye should run the risk of the tempest of almighty wrath; you are invited to find shelter and to enjoy it now

Charles H. Spurgeon, Sunday, March 12, 1876 – Deut 4:29-31 Arouse yourself, O man, for immediate action, for if you wait till you have conquered this evil force by your own strength, if you delay to turn unto God until Charles H. Spurgeon you are free from the dominion of sin, bv Alexander Melville then assuredly you will wait for ever, and perish in your folly. If you could vanquish evil by your own power you would not need to seek the Lord, for you would have found salvation in yourself, don't be so infatuated to DREAM of such a thing.




- 1-4 1st Address of Moses Reviews 40-Year Trek
- 4:1-2 Now, Israel, hear the ... laws I am about to teach you. Follow them so that you may live ... & take possession of the land
 - 2 Do not add ... & do not subtract from it, but keep the commands of the Lord your God that I give you.

Moses reminds - be careful - remember what you have seen

4:11 You came near & stood at the foot of the mountain while it blazed with fire to the very heavens, with black clouds and deep darkness.

Moses recalls what his audience's FATHERS, MOTHERS, Grandparents

Told every year at Passover



Deuteronomy is Moses' Last Farewell

Moses KNEW stakes were HIGH right from the START **ABRAHAM** was the **FATHER** of Isaac & Jacob = Israel **MOSES** was the **DELIVERER** of Israel's 12 Tribes

Genesis & N.T. = GOD was the FATHER of CHRIST

N.T. = CHRIST was the DELIVERER on the CROSS

Revelation CHRIST DELIVERS us to HEAVEN

Moses & Elijah were with Christ on the Mt of Transfiguration
Duet 34 records the death of Moses and God burying Moses
We do NOT know much of Moses' *PERSON*, yet from
34 chapters of Deuteronomy, we see a HEART for God


- 4:12 Then the Lord spoke to you out of the fire.

 You heard the sound of words but saw no form....
- 13 He declared to you his covenant, the **Ten Commandments**He commanded you to follow ... wrote them on two stone tablets

As eloquent as Spurgeon, Moses continues

4:9 Only be careful! Watch yourselves closely so that you do not forget the things your EYES HAVE SEEN or let them fade from your heart as long as you live.

Teach them to your children and to their children after them.

If you desire to be saved, there must be NO playing and NO toying, trifling and feigning.


The search must be read, sincere, and earnest, fervent, intense, thorough-going, or it will be a failure.

Is this too much to ask?

Surely if anything in the world deserves earnestness it is this.

If anything ought to arouse ALL a man's powers to energy,

it is the salvation of his SOUL

You cannot win gold & attain riches without being in earnest in the pursuit.


But what deserves the greatest EARNESTNESS?

If you trifle upon any matters of importance, yet HERE at any rate be serious, solemn, and earnest.



Charles H. Spurgeon, Sunday, March 12, 1876 - Deut 4:29-31 Here there must be NO idling and NO delay! Note that there is a repetition in the text. "If thou seek him with ALL THY HEART and with ALL THY SOUL." Charles H. Spurgeon by Alexander Melville We must be doubly in earnest, heart & soul must be in the pursuit. Half-hearted seeking is NO SEEKING AT ALL.... If you are content to be put off with an inferior blessing, you are not seeking the Lord at all.
