The LORD our God, the LORD is ONE.


6:4 FIRST Hebrew WORD is ♣ hema

Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the DOORFRAMES of your houses and on your gates.















Moses' Law CODE is one of the earliest in history after a few like Moses' "Torah" = Instruction, Law = all 5 books Pentateuch

Genesis, Exodus, Lev, Num, Deuteronomy

c. 1754 B.C. Code of Hammurabi Earliest & most complete coding

Babylonian King Hammurabi, w 282 laws

Code of Hammurabi known for its "Lex Talionis" translated "Law of Retaliation or Retribution"

similar Lex Talionis in Exodus 21:24, 300 or 500 years later "an eye for an eye" & "tooth for a tooth"

Other early Code of Ur-Nammu of Ur c. 2100 B.C.

codes: Code of Lipit-Ishtar of Isin c. 1934 B.C.

Laws of Eshnunna c. 1930 B.C.

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After HEART pleadings to LOVE GOD & gentle nudges in 5-7
WE have Numerous Laws – some touched last week to chap 8-11
Chapter 12-26 cover a TRUCK LOAD of Domestic Laws

Deuteronomy 12 opens with several powerful verses

- 1 These are the decrees and laws you must be careful to follow in the land that the LORD, the God of your ancestors, has given you to possess—as long as you live in the land.
- 2 DESTROY completely all the places ... mountains ... hills ... under every spreading tree, where the nations you are dispossessing worship their gods.
- 3 BREAK down their altars, SMASH ...
 BURN their Asherah poles in the fire;
 CUT DOWN the idols of their gods....

Ten Commandments are important—yet Moses does not does not separate them from chapters 8-26

While the Ten Commandments stand out, which ever version

Moses did NOT distinguish - Moses DOUBLES down on 8-26

That is - Deut 8-26 is big part of "THE LAW"!




Deuteronomy 12 – a preface – a summary for action

- 4 You must not worship the LORD your God in their way.
- 5 But you are to seek the place the LORD your God will choose from among ... to put his Name there

 To that place you must go
- 6-7 Explains offerings, tithes, gifts, firstborn of herds you & families shall eat & rejoice in everything...
- 8-14 Moses gives warning to ONLY worship where He says
- 15-28 Moses gives summary of how eat, more in 13-26
- 29-31 Moses tells how God will HELP their invasion
 - 31 They burn their sons & daughters in the fire as sacrifices....
- 12:32 See that you do all I command you;

 DO NOT ADD to it or TAKE AWAY from it.

Do we "TAKE AWAY" when we post the Ten Commandments?



Ten Commandments?

- ✓ Which ever version ... or which version
- I'm not fighting against classroom posting
- ✓ But there are concerns about STATE-orders
- ✓ Seems to me a GREATER concern is over motives: like some kind of naïve belief or covert deception that posting will "Make One Moral"
- ✓ Or is motive as simple as these TEN WE VALUE?
- ✓ Or perhaps, CHRISTIAN dominance by state ORDERS?
- ✓ Why not ORDER "Love God & Love Others"? ouch!

Deuteronomy 8-26 is blood kin to 5-7 – so Shema/HEAR

NO ONE here has, IS, WANTS to do 95% of LAW in 8-26



Ten Commandments?

Herein—TWO Thought Streams of Relevance Emerge

- 1. Ten Cs are Connected to WHOLE Law, inseparable
- 2. Israelites Did NOT then, NOR DO WE TODAY keep the WHOLE LAW much is ILLEGAL Today

RELEVANCE – State Orders of the POSTING of Ten Cs ARE in FACT a State Endorsement of WHOLE O.T. Law

- ✓ No One Today WANTS to DO 70% of WHOLE
- ✓ Some of "The Law" is considered EVIL Today
- ✓ Height of "The Law" is summed "Love God, Love Others"
- ✓ Israel in 1400 B.C. Did NOT Believe in Freedom of Religion
- ✓ New Testament Desires Willing HEART over Compulsion

13:1 If a prophet foretells ... a sign or wonder

... "Follow gods" ... do not listen


The LORD your God is testing you ...

Keep his commands....

that prophet ... be put to DEATH ...

These are NOT less than the

Ten Commandments



Deuteronomy 13:1-18

- 5 That prophet or dreamer tried to turn you from the way the LORD....
- 6 If your very own brother ... son ... daughter ... wife you love, or your closest friend secretly entices you to go after other gods Show them no pity.... 9 You must certainly put them to DEATH. Your hand must be the first in putting them to DEATH, and then the hands of all the people.
- 12-18 If you hear of a town where troublemakers want other gods Investigate ... if so
 - ✓ KILL ALL, people & livestock
 - **✓ PLUNDER & Burn Town—Completely!**
 - ✓ Town must remain RUIN FOREVER

THEN Lord will ...

increase your numbers....




Deuteronomy 14:1-29

- 1 You are the children of the LORD your God. Do not CUT yourselves or shave the front of your heads for the dead,
- 2 for you are a people holy to the LORD your God....
- 3 Do not eat any detestable thing.
- 4-10 Lists good and bad animals. No Eat Pigs! Yes to FISH.
- 11-18 May eat any clean bird. NO eagle, vulture ...
 No falcon, raven, owl, gull, hawk, stork, heron ...
- 19 No flying insects
- 21 Do not eat anything DEAD.

 You CAN give DEAD to foreigner ...

 Do not cook a young goat in its mother's milk.






Deuteronomy 15:5:1-23 At the end of every sevents is how it is to be

- 1 At the end of every seven years you must CANCEL DEBTS.
- 2-5 This is how it is to be done in essence, cancel ALL Israelite debts, NOT a foreigner's debts
- 6 For the LORD your God will bless you as he has promised....
- 7-10 Help the poor ... do not be hardhearted....
- 11 There will always be poor people in the land. Therefore ... be openhanded to ... poor and needy in your land.
- 12-18 Free servants on 7th year ... feed them
 - 15 Remember you were slaves....
 - 16 But if servant wants to STAY ... earring in ear ... servant for life.
- 19 Set apart ... firstborn of your herds...

 Eat them each year for Lord....

 Do not eat blood....



Deuteronomy 16:1-22

- 1 Observe the month of Aviv and celebrate the Passover of the LORD your God, because in the month of Aviv he brought you out of Egypt by night.
- 2-8 Explains details of Sacrifice as the Passover
- 9-13 Explains Festival of Weeks, 7 weeks of harvest, then sacrifice 12 Remember ... Egypt ... follow carefully these decrees.
- 13-15 Explains Festival of Tabernacles
- 16 3x a year ... choose place for Festivals
 - 1. Unleavened Bread 2. of Weeks
 - 3. Festival of Tabernacles
- Who even THINKS of doing these?
- 18-20 Appoint judges.... follow justice
- 21 No Asherah pole or sacred stone that LORD your God hates

Deuteronomy 17:1-20 1 Do not sacrifice ... ox or sheep that has any defect ... detestable.... 2-5 If a man or woman ... doing evil in the eyes of the LORD ... contrary to my command worshiped other gods.... IF TRUE ... STONE THAT PERSON TO DEATH. 6-7 On the testimony of two or three witnesses ... DEATH.... Hands of witnesses FIRST, then ALL the people. purge the evil from among you. 8-13 Cases ... bloodshed, lawsuits, assaults-Go to priests ... do what they say 14 Explains how to choose a KING that the Lord approves, no foreigner We don't do any of those either nor want to post those

Deuteronomy 18:1-22

- 1 Levitical priests—NO inheritance.... live on offerings to the LORD....
- 2-8 Explains in detail LORD is their inheritance
 God has chosen them ... minister in the LORD's name always
- 9-13 Explains in detail NO SACRIFICE OF CHILDREN
 ANY who practice divination, sorcery, omens, witchcraft,
 casts spells, is a medium or spiritist, consults the dead.
 Anyone who does ... detestable to the LORD....
- 14-22 ... LORD ... will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you....
 I will put my words in his mouth....

Yet a false prophets or prophet of other gods

is to be put to DEATH

No freedom of religion there Not posting those in any U.S. school

Deuteronomy 21:1-23 – Various TOUGH LAWS

- 1-9 Murder find town nearest victim
- 10-14 Sex with beautiful captive women OKAY
- 15-17 If a man has two wives ... loves one ... both bear him sons firstborn is the son of the WIFE HE DOES NOT LOVE MUST STILL give rights of firstborn to son of unloved wife
- 18-21 ... rebellious son ... not obey father & mother ...
 MEN OF HIS TOWN ARE TO STONE HIM TO DEATH....

22-23 If body of guilty is exposed on a pole....

Must not hang ther OVERNIGHT

Deuteronomy 22:1-12 CLOTHING

22:5 A woman must not wear men's clothing nor a man wear women's clothing, for the Lord your God DETESTS

ANYONE WHO DOES THIS.

Most of Deuteronomy as Moses gives The Law Hard to imagine how often God felt just like Coco, the Big Dog to Bruno, the little God




Deuteronomy 22:13-30 – Marriage Violations

- 13-21 Proof of Virginity Grossly DETAILED

 If no proof ... men of her town shall stone her to death.

 You must purge the evil from among you.
- 22 Man sleeps another man's wife BOTH KILLED.
- 23 If man sleeps with a pledged virgin in TOWN BOTH KILLED ...
 if, if, if she did not scream for help....
 You must purge the evil from among you.
- 25 But if man rapes in the country KILL only the man.
- 28 If man rapes virgin not pledged ... pay the father 50 shekels & MARRY
- 30 Man is not to marry his father's wife...

NOT posting those in any school



Deuteronomy 23:1-25 1 No one emasculated ... enter assembly of LORD. 2 No one born of a forbidden marriage, nor any of their descendants enter the assembly ... not even in the 10th generation. 3-6 No Ammonite or Moabite ... 10th generation 7-8 Edomites are related to you ... 3rd generation OKAY 9-14 Explains uncleanness in camp 15-16 If a slave has taken refuge ... do not oppress 17 No Israelite man or woman to be a shrine prostitute. 18 DO NOT bring the earnings of a female or male prostitute into the house of the LORD 19-20 Do not charge a fellow Israelite interest 21-23 KEEP your VOWS 24-25 Eat neighbors grapes & grain

Deuteronomy 24:1-22 1-4 Odd Divorce if Woman "displeases" & remarries 5 Newly married not to war for a year.... 6 Do not take a pair of millstones ... for debt.... 7 ... kidnapping a fellow Israelite ... must die. You must purge the evil from among you. 8-10 ... skin diseases ... do exactly as priests instruct. 10-13 When you make a loan ... explains how to handle pledges 14-15 Hired workers ... pay before sunset 16 Don't KILL Parents children's sin ... Don't KILL children for parent's sin. 17-18 Justice to foreigners, fatherless, widows 19-22 Leave extra during harvest for the foreigners, fatherless, widows won't hang these up in School

Deuteronomy 25:1-19

- 1-3 When people have a dispute ...

 Explains taking to court ... if guilty person deserves to be beaten flogged in his presence ... lashes crime deserves ... <40!
- 4 Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain.
- 5-10 Law on brothers taking widow ...
- 11-12 If two men fighting ... wife seizes private parts attacking man Cut off her hand. Show her NO PITY.
- 13-16 Do not have two differing weights .. LORD detests ... dishonestly.
- 17-19 Illustrates injustice by recalling how they were treated by Amalekites
- Won't hang those up in School

Deuteronomy 26:1-19 1-11 When you have entered the land the LORD your God is giving you basket some firstfruits ... take to place God says Explains how to give to Levites as a thanks for deliverance 12-15 Explains how to give the 3rd Year Tithe to the Levite Moses closes Deuteronomy 26 on HOW TO PRAY TO GOD: 13 Then say to the LORD your God: "I have removed from my house the sacred portion ... given to Levite, foreigner, fatherless & widow.... I have not turned from your commands. 15 Look down from heaven ... bless your people Israel.

Deuteronomy 26:1-19

- 16 LORD your God commands you this day ... THESE Decrees & LAWS carefully observe them with all your heart and all your soul.
- 17 You have declared this day that the LORD is your God and that YOU WILL WALK IN OBEDIENCE ...

 KEEP His commands & laws
 that you will listen to Him.

LISTEN

KEEP His Commands & Laws KEEP 5-26 – ALL OF THEM THAT you will LISTEN TO HIM



When you separate The Law, you DISOBEY God

Deuteronomy 26:1-19

18 LORD has declared this day that you are his people, his treasured possession ... that you are to KEEP ALL HIS COMMANDS.

Who can FAIL to see the continuity, the connectiveness?

A peculiar special fulfillment is coming in Christ

Moses' Last Farewell—anchored in God's Promises

19 He has declared that He will set you in praise, fame & honor high above ALL THE NATIONS he has made and you will be a people holy to the LORD your God, as He promised.
