gods of silver or gods of gold.







Only Moses is to come to the Lord


Moses WROTE down everything




Deuteronomy is given AFTER Israel's 40 years wandering

Exodus 29:45-46

⁴⁵ Then I will dwell among the Israelites and be their God.

46 They will know that I am the LORD their God, who brought them out of Egypt so that I might dwell among them.
I am the LORD their God.


Exodus 31:18 closes

When the LORD finished speaking to Moses on Mount Sinai, he gave him the TWO TABLETS of the COVENANT LAW, the tablets of stone inscribed by the finger of God

Ten Commandments: Ex. 20:1-17 = Covenant 3x = Ex. 34:28 ... Deut. 4:13 ... Deut. 10:4

Hebrew root דָּבָר trans. "command"

*Debar ... "speech, word"




40 Days & Nights ... Tabernacle Instructions

Ten Commandments: Ex. 20:1-17 = Covenant 3x = Ex. 34:28 ... Deut. 4:13 ... Deut. 10:4

First occurrence of "Ten Commandments" occurs in Exodus 34:28,

Moses ... with the LORD 40 days and forty nights without eating bread or drinking water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant—the Ten Commandments.



At the end of 40 years of wandering

Deuteronomy = "Second Law"

The 2nd occurrence in Deuteronomy 4:13 Moses reminds them

He declared to you his covenant, the

Ten Commandments, which he commanded you to follow and then wrote them on two stone tablets.

3rd occurrence in Deut. 10 deserves a little background . . . After 40 YEARS

Moses recalls his experience on Sinai



Deut. 9 ... Moses recalls their rebellion when he came down from Mt. Sinai or Mt. Horeb


Deut. 9:11, At the end of the forty days and forty nights, the LORD gave me the two stone tablets, the tablets of the covenant.

Deut. 9:17, Moses reminded them of how he BROKE the tablets

Deut. 9:18, Then once again I fell prostrate before the LORD for forty days and forty nights; I ate no bread and drank no water, because of all the sin you had committed....

God wants to DESTROY Aaron ...

Moses prays ...



Now hear this ...

Deut. 10:1, At that time the LORD said to me, "Chisel out two stone tablets like the first ones and come up to me on the mountain. Also make a wooden ark."

10:4, The LORD wrote on these tablets what he had written before, Ten Commandments he had proclaimed to you on the mountain, out of the fire, on the day of the assembly. And the LORD gave them to me.

Hebrew is "Ten Words" – Ten Commands

Third time Ten Commands appears in O.T.

In Exodus ... often called "The Testimony"


- ¹ The LORD said to Moses,

Exodus 25:1-7 – Offering – Take an Offering from All Willing

God explains more ...

These are the offerings you are to receive from them: gold, silver and bronze;

4-5 blue, purple and scarlet yarn and fine linen; goat hair; ram skins dyed red and another type of durable leather; acacia wood,

6-7 olive oil for the light; spices for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense; and onyx stones and other gems to be mounted on the ephod and breastpiece.

Exodus 25:8-9 – The Purpose – Make a Sanctuary for Me

Beautiful tabernacle has a purpose

8 "Then have them make a sanctuary for me, and I will dwell among them.

⁹ Make this tabernacle and all its furnishings exactly like the pattern I will show you.


God goes to GREAT lengths

Exodus 31:1-6 - Leaders - Gifted Artisans Bezalel & Oholiab

STILL on Mt. Sinai - 40 Days & Nights

- ¹ Then the LORD said to Moses,
- ² "See, I have chosen Bezalel son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah,
- ³ and I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with wisdom, with understanding, with knowledge and with all kinds of skills—
- 4-5 to make artistic designs for work in gold, silver and bronze, to cut and set stones, to work in wood, and to engage in all kinds of crafts.
