40 Days & Nights ... Tabernacle Instructions

Exodus 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31

Lengthy, detailed Tabernacle instructions

Exodus 31:12-17 ... more on Sabbath, again


Exodus 31:18 closes

When the LORD finished speaking to Moses on Mount Sinai, he gave him the TWO TABLETS of the COVENANT LAW, the tablets of stone inscribed by the finger of God

Two Tablets have Ten Commandments

Ex. 20:1-17 = Covenant ... "ten" seen 3x

3x = Ex. 34:28 ... Deut. 4:13 ... Deut. 10:4



AFTER Israel builds Golden Calf Ex. 32:1-14 Exodus 32:15-29 tell us plainly

Moses—READY to descend from Mt. Sinai

Moses—READY to go down from Mt. Horeb

BEFORE Moses goes down

God is AWARE of all that is going on


God tells Moses ... and Moses PRAYS

Moses prays BEFORE he SEES

Moses prays from hearing God's words

Moses heads down with two tablets, written on the front and back ... meets Joshua

Joshua thinks there is victory



Exodus 32:16 ... as Moses goes down

32:16:


The tablets were the work of God; the writing was the writing of God, engraved on the tablets.

Moses meets Joshua who hears NOISE thinking he missed a great victory party

32:18 Moses replied [to Joshua]:

"It is not the sound of victory, it is not the sound of defeat...."

Then ... we have to share some background
What happened *AFTER* the Mad Cow Disease



After mass infection of Mad Cow Disease— Moses goes BERSERK!

Of all things, Moses Grabbed the


Wild Horse's Reins



After mass infection of Mad Cow Disease— Moses took CONTROL!

Exodus 32:19-35

- ¹⁹ When Moses approached the camp and saw the calf and the dancing, his anger burned and he threw the tablets out of his hands, breaking them to pieces at the foot of the mountain.
- ²⁰ And he took the calf the people had made and burned it in the fire; then he ground it to powder, scattered it on the water and made the Israelites drink it.
 - Moses said to Aaron, "What did these people DO TO YOU, that you led them into such great sin?"



Poor Aaron ... Exodus 32:22-24

²² "Do not be angry, my lord," Aaron answered. "You know how prone these people are to evil.....

Aaron ... the pitiful ... bla, bla, bla

Aaron confesses his utter cowardice

Exodus 32:22-24 makes you want to cry

Moses ain't havin' it ... ain't hearin' it

²⁵ Moses saw that the people were running wild and that Aaron had let them get out of control and so become a laughingstock to their enemies.

No excuse ... Moses just takes charge

Moses is as strong here as EVER in all of the Book of the Exodus


²⁶ So Moses stood at the entrance to the camp and said,

"Whoever is for the LORD, come to me."

And all the Levites rallied to him.

Moses orders the men to Lock'n Load Swords ON ... and ...


Listen to Moses' ORDERS:

Go back and forth through the camp From one end to the other, each killing his brother and friend and neighbor.'

Locked 'n Loaded

Levites went forth

3,000 Died

Next, the SERMON ... here's a News Headline

Pastor KILLS 3,000 then Preaches!

²⁹ Then Moses said, "You have been set apart to the LORD today, for you were against your own sons and brothers, and he has blessed you this day."

Moses asks for MERCY

OKAY ... Lord will NOT destroy ALL!


LORD struck the people with a plague




² Aaron answered them, "Take off the gold earrings that your wives, your sons and your daughters are wearing, and bring them to me."

Moses ... on Mt. Sinai 40 Days & Nights Rebellion & calf building had to commence on week 2 or 3 ... so SOOON

Moses & God

Taken for Granted

Out of Sight

Out of Mind & Heart



Aaron ... who walked the 300+ miles from Mt. Sinai to Raamses with Moses

Aaron ... who witnessed MORE than most

⁴ Aaron took what they handed him and made it into an idol cast in the shape of a calf, fashioning it with a tool.

Hammering for a few days, I suppose

Then they said, "These are your gods, Israel, who brought you up out of Egypt."

Who was that spokesman?
Who said that?

Now caught up in it all


Aaron TRIES to make the idolatry RIGHT

⁵ When Aaron saw this, he built an altar in front of the calf and announced, "Tomorrow there will be a festival to the LORD."

⁶ So the next day the people rose early and sacrificed burnt offerings and presented fellowship offerings.

Afterward, they sat down to eat and drink and got up to indulge in revelry.

According to Keil and Delitzsch, Israel made the Golden Calf after Egyptian Apis

NOT meant to be the Egyptian god itself

Apis looking Mad Cow ...

supposed to represent


YHWH - Creator!

Israel chose one of the chief Egyptian gods to represent & worship YHWH

In other words, they were NOT trying to recreate Apis or worship Apis

They chose the Apis BULL to represent

YHWH God



MOO-olatry

In Exodus 7 ... back in September we touched on the Egyptian Gods

Apis, god of Memphis, a live BULL

"live" gods died, they were mummified

Apis mediated between humans and some of the higher gods

Arose in the 1st Dynasty c. 3000 B.C.

Some suggest Apis was among the 1st of the fertility gods, concerned with grain & herds

Apis was depicted black or white ...

Born from a ray of light ... ahhhh

Lite BULL ... or BULL Lite?



Statue of Apis in Louvre 13th dynasty, c. 1800-1639 B.C.

Priests got "direction" or "omens"

from the BULL's behavior ..

Yes sir ... yes ma'am ...

The Bull shook his mighty head

Priests said, "Bull said YES" or "Bull said NO"


Now then ... my friends, that is a lot of

BULL

6700–5650 B.C. temples & furniture in Anatolia (Turkey today) were adorned with BULL heads

That is a whole lot more

BULL



Statue of Apis in Louvre 13th dynasty, c. 1800-1639 B.C.

Several "bull" cults in Ancient Egypt

Apis was the chief BULL god

Here is a BULL from the tomb of boy King Tut ... now in Luxor Museum

King Tut ruled in the 18th dynasty, c. 1332–1323 B.C.

After Thutmose or before Raamses

That is, THIS BULL was placed after or before the Exodus

That means that ...

King Tut took his BULL with him



Secret Cult of Mithras arose in the Roman army not long after Christ

Some secular scholars claim it competed with early Christianity in growth

Mithraism SECRET cult w grades of initiation

God Mithra is always depicted killing a bull

New convert was "initiated" with a bull killed over him in a pit ... blood pouring on him

Mithra, born out of a rock ... means "friend"

100s of these carvings, 1000+ inscriptions relate Mithraism's popularity in the Roman army

Mithras killing the bull c. A.D. 200, in Louvre

Cult died out c. A.D. 400 ... much remains Secret today

Psalm 106 poetically describes Israel's rebellion so well ... including Exodus 32

Psalm 106:1-6 ... Praises God

⁷ When our ancestors were in Egypt, they gave no thought to your miracles; they did not remember your many kindnesses, and they rebelled by the sea, the Red Sea.

Psalm 106:8-18, rebellion of Dathan Num. 16

Psalm 106:19-27, relates the Golden Calf

Psalm 106:28-31 laments Israel eating to other gods & Phineas' intervened

Psalm 106:32-46, waters of Meribah

Psalm 106:47-48 closes in prayer & praise

Psalm 106:19-27 laments Exodus 32

- 19 At Horeb they made a calf and worshiped an idol cast from metal.
- ²⁰ They exchanged their glorious God for an image of a bull, which eats grass.
- ²¹ They forgot the God who saved them...
- ²³ So God said he would destroy them—had not Moses, his chosen one, stood in the breach before him to keep his wrath from destroying them.
- 24 Then they despised the pleasant land; they did not believe his promise.



Psalm 106:19-27 laments Exodus 32

- ²⁵ They grumbled in their tents and did not obey the LORD.
- ²⁶ So God swore to them with uplifted hand that he would make them fall in the wilderness,
- 27 make their descendants fall among the nations and scatter them throughout the lands.

And 40 years they wandered ...

The whole generation perishing except Joshua and Caleb.





- ⁷ Then the LORD said to Moses, "Go down, because your people, whom you brought up out of Egypt, have become corrupt.
- 8 They have been quick to turn away from what I commanded them and have made themselves an idol cast in the shape of a CALF.

They have bowed down to it and sacrificed to it and have said, 'These are your gods, Israel, who brought you up out of Egypt.'

NOTHING more offensive to God


FIRST Commandment – busted to pieces

⁹ "I have seen these people," the LORD said to Moses, "and they are a stiff-necked people.

What God says next is astonishing ... so very HUMAN ... and so painful

Now leave me alone so that my anger may burn against them and that I may DESTROY THEM.

Then I will make you into a great nation."

Moses ... STILL on Mt. Sinai
When Moses heard God say that:

¹¹ Moses sought the favor of the LORD his God.

"LORD," he said, "why should your anger burn against your people, whom You brought out of Egypt with great power and a mighty hand?

Moses REASONS with God
Moses APPEALS to God

Listen to Moses' kindly heart



Also ... remember

Recall that Moses is STILL on the mountain

Moses is STILL with God on Mt. Sinai

Moses has not yet CONFRONTED Israel

Moses has not yet SEEN first hand the

Mad Cow Disease

Listen to Moses

Remember ... Moses is still with God



Listen to PASTOR Moses' heart

Why should the Egyptians say, 'It was with evil intent that he brought them out, to kill them in the mountains and

to wipe them off the face of the earth'?

Turn from your fierce anger; relent

and do not bring disaster on your people.

Moses ... still on Mt. Sinai ...

13 Remember your servants Abraham, Isaac and Israel, to whom you swore by your own self:

Moses appeals to GOD's own HONOR!

God does NOT destroy them How DID God respond?

14 Then the LORD relented and did not bring on his people the disaster he had threatened.

Yet ... MOSES cometh

Rest of the story is that God ...

Through MOSES ... still kills 3,000

Through MOSES ... still sends a plague

Yes, God relented ...

God did not TOTALLY destroy them

Moses breaks the Ten Commandments


