uninvited

Last half of Exodus ... Israel at the foot of Mt. Sinai

15-18 > To Sinai: Bitter Water, Quail, Manna, Water, Amalek, Jethro Advises

19-24 > At the Foot of Mount Sinai: God on Mt. Sinai ... Covenant Ten Commandments GIVEN to ALL Israel ... then Covenant Law to Moses

25:1-31:11, Tabernacle Specs Given on Mt. Sinai

31:12-35:3, Between Specs & Build

- ✓ Two Tablets
- ✓ Mad Cow Disease & Judgment
- ✓ Moses again 40 days
- ✓ Another Set of Tablets
- ✓ Moses' Shining Face
- ✓ Another Reminder of Sabbath

35:4 to 39:43, MOSES instructs ALL




Exodus 39:42-43 – Finished – Moses Inspected & Blessed 35:4 to 39:43, MOSES instructing ALL

- ⁴² Israelites had done ALL the work just as the LORD had commanded Moses.
- 43 Moses inspected the work and saw that they had done it just as the LORD had commanded.

So Moses BLESSED them.

Exodus 40:1-4 Assembly Required – "Set Up the Tabernacle"

Chapter 40 opens with ORDERS

- ¹ Then the LORD said to Moses:
- ² "Set up the tabernacle, the tent of meeting, on the first day of the first month.
- ³ Place the ark of the covenant law in it and shield the ark with the curtain.
- ⁴ Bring in the table and set out what belongs on it. Then bring in the lampstand and set up its lamps.




Exodus 40:5-33 Tabernacle Set Up

- ✓ Thou shalt set ... the Laver

- ✓ Thou shalt bring Aaron ...

40:16-33, Moses does all the above





Exodus 40:36-38 God Led – "In all the Travels"

Intriguing ... see this:

- ³⁶ In all the travels of the Israelites, whenever the cloud lifted from above the tabernacle, they would set out;
- 37 but if the cloud did not lift, they did not set out—until the day it lifted.
- 38 So the cloud of the LORD was over the tabernacle by day, and fire was in the cloud by night, in the sight of all the Israelites during all their travels.

Now that is very, very convenient ...

Exodus 40:38-39 the is most intriguing

Twice ... two times in a row

glory of the LORD

filled the tabernacle.

We've heard that from our youth. The renditions in art are few ... WHY? What is to SHOW? ... a CLOUD? What is clear ... even spectacular Is that ISRAEL knew ... more than a "cloud" Over the centuries, a term has come into use

Shekinah = to settle, inhabit, dwell Hebrew transliterated into English Hebrew "shekinah" made w English letters


Shekinah = "to settle, inhabit, dwell"
Root often used for birds "settling, nesting"
Tabernacle SAME root: "dwelling" place

Shekinah refers to "Divine Presence"

Some see the Shekinah interpreted into the Greek term Parousia, "coming"

As in Matthew 24:3,

"What will the sign of your COMING"



Parousia 24x in N.T.

- √ of Paul & others
- ✓ Lawless One in 2 Thess.
- ✓ 17x as Second COMING of Christ

Shekinah = to settle, inhabit, dwell


- ✓ Doesn't appear in the Bible
- ✓ Doesn't appear in early rabbinic literature
- ✓ Doesn't appear in the Dead Sea Scrolls

Some believe the term came into use AFTER Romans destroyed Temple A.D. 70

Root for birds "settling, nesting"

Root for Tabernacle as a "dwelling" place

Shekinah refers to "Divine Presence"




Tabernacle of God in the Wilderness

Shekinah = to settle, inhabit, dwell See the Divine Presence in the O.T. Samuel anointed Saul, then said in 1 Sam. 10:6,

The Spirit of the LORD will come powerfully upon you, and you will prophesy with them; and you will be changed into a different person.

There are other times and ways

A similarly spectacular "coming" was when Solomon finished the Temple


Solomon's Temple

1 Kings 6:1, in the 418th year that Israel came out of Egypt ... in the 4th year of Solomon's reign He began to build the temple

1 Kings 6:2-38, building of the Temple

1 Kings 7, Palace & Temple are FINISHED

- 1 Kings 7:51, Solomon brought all the things his "father" King David had dedicated into the Temple Treasury
- 1 Kings 8, with great pomp & ceremony Solomon brings the Ark of the Covenant into the great Temple


Solomon's Temple

Ark of the Covenant in the great Temple

Ark had ONLY two tablets placed in it by Moses at Horeb

- 1 Kings 8:10-11, Glory of the LORD
 - ¹⁰ When the priests withdrew from the Holy Place, the cloud filled the temple of the LORD.
 - 11 the priests could not perform their service because of the cloud, for the glory of the LORD

filled his temple.

Jewish tradition informs us more

Shekinah – "glory" & "radiance" is said:

✓ Rests on the Pious & Righteous

✓ Rests on 10 or more Worshippers PRAYING

✓ Rests on those Studying the Torah

✓ Rests on Jews Reciting the Shema Deut. 6:4

- ✓ Rests on Holy Places: Mt. Sinai, Tabernacle, Temple
- ✓ Rests on the Chaste & Benevolent
- ✓ Rests on Husband & Wife when they live in peace and harmony





Shekinah = to settle, inhabit, dwell


Jewish scholars definitively note the Shekinah as God's Presence

- ✓ Rests on those PLACES God sanctifies
- ✓ Rests on those OBJECTS God sanctifies
- ✓ Rests on those INDIVIDUALS God sanctifies
- ✓ Rests on a whole PEOPLE God sanctifies

In the above, this is a

"revelation of the holy in the midst of the profane."*



Shekinah = to settle, inhabit, dwell

NOT Rabbis, but later Jewish Philosophers went in another direction altogether

Philosophers were did NOT see GOD or see God's ESSENCE in the Shekinah

DENIED all forms of anthropomorphism giving human attributes to God or animal


Rather, Shekinah was a separate entity created by GOD ...

HIS GLORY ... "Light or Radiance" itself

"Light" mediated between God & Man

Sometimes ... catch this ... GRAB THIS

"Light" mediating appeared in form of a MAN

Maimonides

Rabbi Moses ben Maimon (1135-1204)

One of the most revered, prolific Rabbis

Maimonides explained the Shekinah

As "created light" = identified as "Glory"

An overflow from God through the intellect
