



Gen 12:1 The Lord had said to Abram,\*

"Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you.

Abram's father Terah passed a Sethite legacy of God-fearing w/out any Bible

Lord came to Abram ... cause Abram BELIEVED ...

I suspect ... even believe ... that the "oath" he swore in chapter 15 Was an "oath" he swore BEFORE chapter 12 ...

an "oath" he swore sometime earlier during his 1st 75 Silent Years

Abram left Harran a mature 75-year-old very HONORABLE man of FAITH

Left Harran ALREADY a well-measured Man


Kind of a Pre-Covenant 1 ... looking to Gen 17, Covenant of Circumcision Preparing Abram for when God changes Abram to become Abraham

Gen 12:4 So Abram went, as the Lord had told him; and Lot went with him. Abram was 75 years old when he set out from Harran.

5 He took his wife Sarai, nephew Lot, all the possessions ... & the people they had acquired in Harran, they set out for the land of Canaan ... arrived there.

6 Abram traveled through the land as far as GREAT TREE OF MOREH at Shechem. ... the Canaanites were in the land.

Often "OAK" or "Terebinth" a solitary tree
Several species of OAK ...
Terebinth used to make turpentine




Gen 12:7 The Lord appeared to Abram and said, "To your offspring I will give this land."
So he built an altar there to the Lord, who had appeared to him.

Aahhhh Pre-Covenant 2 ... preparing Abram to Abraham in Gen 17 ... Promise of Land & Long Lineage ...

8 From there he went on toward the hills east of Bethel and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west & Ai on the east.


Abram built an altar to the Lord & CALLED on the name of the Lord.

Gen 12:9 9 Then Abram set out & continued toward the Negev








Gen 12:10 Now there was a famine in the land, Abram went down to Egypt ... a while ....

- 11 As he was about to enter Egypt,
  he said to his wife Sarai,
  "I know what a beautiful woman you are.
- 12 When the Egyptians see you, they will say, 'This is his wife.' ... KILL me but let you LIVE.
- 13 Say you are my sister, so that
  I will be treated well for your sake and
  my LIFE will be spared because of YOU."


Abram is 80ish & Sarai is 75ish ... holdin' their ages quite well ... soon ...

Abram leads a small army to wallop 4 KINGS ... gonna rescue his nephew Lot & OTHERS

Gen 12:14 When Abram came to Egypt, Egyptians saw Sarai was a very beautiful 75-yr-old woman.

15 When Pharaoh's officials saw her ... Sarai to his palace.

16 He treated Abram well for her sake, and sheep & cattle ... donkeys ... servants, & camels.

We are talking about 2100 B.C.

Great Pyramid of Khufu, 2nd king of 4th dynasty

finished about 2560 B.C. ... 450 years before Abraham

Abraham saw them glistening in the SUN



About 450 years old when Abraham walked among them Still glistening white in the sun ... seen from miles away ...

Gen 12:17 But the Lord inflicted serious diseases on Pharaoh & his household because of Abram's wife Sarai.

18 Pharaoh ... "What have you done?" he said.... "your wife?

19 Why did you say, 'She is my sister,' .. take her to be MY wife?



Now then, here is your wife. Take her & go!"

20 Then Pharaoh gave orders about Abram to his men, they sent him on his way, with his wife & everything he had.

Hard to decipher ...

Except that perhaps Abram misread Pharoh's honor

Yet SOMEONE had related HOW the DISEASES came from ABRAM's GOD


- Gen 13:1 So Abram went up from Egypt to the Negev, with his wife & everything ... & Lot went with him.
- 2 Abram had become very wealthy in livestock & in silver & gold.
- 3-4 From the Negev he went ...
  to the place between Bethel & Ai
  where his tent had been earlier ... first built an altar.

There Abram called on the name of the Lord.

We are seeing a lot of LOT ... Abram's nephew ... Close family ties ... very close ...

Gen 13:5-7 Lot's herdsmen quarrel w Abram's herdsmen ... over grazing

- 8 So Abram said to Lot, "Let's not have any quarreling... for we are close relatives.
- 9 Is not the whole land before you? Let's part company. If you go to the left, I'll go to the right; if you go to the right, I'll go to the left."

LOT has had a lot to do with Abram's FAMILY ...

Lot has become like a SON to Abram .

that's a major part of this story!



A lot centers around LOT ...

How much Abram cares for him ... LENGTHS Abram goes to SAVE

Some see a lot of this as Abram like Christ saving LOT

- Gen 13:10 Lot looked around & saw plain of the Jordan toward Zoar was well watered, like the garden of the Lord, like the land of Egypt.

  (before the Lord destroyed Sodom & Gomorrah.)
- 11 Lot chose ... Jordan & set out east....
- 12 Abram lived in the land of Canaan, while Lot lived among the cities of the plain & pitched his tents near Sodom.
- 13 People of Sodom were wicked ... against the Lord.
- What does Lot fear? ... when you have Abram on your side
  - Lot chose as best he could ... we can assume when choosing
    - For YEARS they grazed all over ... they knew the land & people

Gen 13:14 The Lord said to Abram after Lot had parted from him ...

"Look around from where you are,
to the north and south, to the east and west.

Here is Pre-Covenant 3 ... Land & Long Lineage ...

- 15 All the land that you see I will give to you and your offspring a forever.
- 16 I will make your offspring like the DUST of the earth, so that if anyone could count the DUST, then your offspring could be counted.
- 17 Go, walk through the length & breadth of the LAND, for I am giving it to you."
- 18 So Abram went to live near the great trees of Mamre at Hebron, where he pitched his tents.

  There he built an altar to the Lord.



- 4-7 After 12 yrs of Kedorlaomer in 13th year ... they rebelled.

Kedorlaomer ... defeats Rephaites ... Zuzites ... Emites ... Horites ...

**Amalekites ... Amorites....** 


- 8-10 5 Kings drew battle lines in the Valley of Siddim ... FLED.
- 11 Four kings seized the goods of Sodom & Gomorrah....
- 12 They also carried off Abram's nephew Lot & his possessions since he was living in Sodom.



Gen 14:13 A man escaped came & reported to Abram the Hebrew.

Now Abram was living near the Great Trees of Mamre the Amorite
a brother of Eshkol & Aner, all allied with Abram. @ HEBRON

- 14 When Abram heard ... he called out the 318 trained men born in his household & went in pursuit as far as Dan.
- 15 During the night Abram divided his men to attack them ... routed ... pursuing them as far as Hobah, north of Damascus.
- 16 He recovered ALL & brought back Lot ... & women & others.
- As battles go ... I suspect just a few 1,000s
- SEE how easily Abram believed the MIGHTIER Egyptian Pharaoh might KILL him for Sarai



Gen 14:16 He recovered ALL & brought back Lot ... & women & others.

17 After Abram returned from defeating Kedorlaomer & KINGS ... king of Sodom came out to meet Abram in the Valley of Shaveh the King's Valley.

UP from Sodom to Valley of Shaveh, King's Valley ... AFTER BATTLE \*

**Near Salem ... AFTER the BATTLE** 

Salem would become Jerusalem King's Valley likely Kidron Valley


