

Abraham felt the Call of Duty to God





The Revised Version renders the words, "God did prove Abraham" ... Of course, we shall not ALL attain to the same stature Abraham reached, neither shall we all be tried by the same tests ... but every one of us shall be tested,

Spurgeon said in 1891, but every one of us shall be tested, like Abraham, if indeed we are believers in God. Abraham was the Columbus who, by faith, went out, discovered a better country ... a heavenly . track has been followed by many other voyagers. Not without storms did he cross the sea. WE, TOO, who venture after him on the voyage of faith, must expect to meet with contrary winds, and waves sweeping high.... We should NOT be astonished ... if severe tests should be put upon us before the chapter of life is over.




Sacrifice of Isaac by Caravaggio, 1603

This was Abraham's greatest trial ... tore his heart


On this very verse, Charles H. Spurgeon said in 1891,

It is a great thing that God takes ANY notice of us, poor creatures that we are.

"When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the sun & stars, which thou hast ordained; what is man, that thou art mindful of him?"

We are so insignificant that it is a great wonder that God should come to deal with us at all.

On this very verse, Charles H. Spurgeon said in 1891,


If you saw some tall archangel, whose wand might make a mast for some great man-of-war, bending down over an ant's nest ... you might wonder at his stoop.

But this would be nothing compared with the infinite God, the Maker of all things, condescending to deal with us worms of the earth.

Yet he does so. We are precious in his sight; therefore, as the goldsmith assays the metal ... so doth God test, purify, & try us:

God sets a high value upon us, and therefore he proves us.

Gen: 22:5 He said to his servants, "Stay here with the donkey while I and the boy go over there. **WE** will worship and then WE will come back to you." 6 Abraham took the wood for the burnt offering & placed it on his son Isaac, and he Abraham himself carried the fire & the knife. WE – said Abraham WE – you & me cannot escape that WE – Abraham, 100+ yrs old … knew there was more … WE – Abraham knew God would keep HIS promise

On this very verse, Charles H. Spurgeon said in 1891, My last thought is most precious. Since the believer is thus prepared by grace Lord's call, as Abraham did, when he said, "Here am I," he will be kept ready to the end. My great desire is, that you & I should be ready for anything that the Lord wills ... so if Christ should come at cock-crowing, or ... at midday, or midnight, we should be ready.... if we should lose our dearest friend, our choicest treasure, our health — anything or everything yet still we should each one say ...



Gen: 22:15-16 Angel of the Lord + called to Abraham from heaven a 2nd time "I swear by myself, declares the Lord, that because you have done this & have not withheld your son, your only son,

17 I will surely bless you & make your descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky & as the sand on the seashore.
Your descendants will take possession of the cities of their enemies,

18 thru your offspring ALL nations on earth will be blessed, because you have obeyed me."

If it is thy will, it is my will. If thou sayest it, so be it; for who am I, and what is thy servant, that I should dare to dispute with the infinite wisdom of INFALLIBLE LOVE?" Happy is the man who can say, "Here am I."
