





hence Fire & Food



Why should they starve? ... "Feed My Sheep"

Go as Peter, the Rock, if you can but if you cannot do so, go as "Simon, Son of Jonas" – the Dove



John 21:18 Very truly I tell you, when you were younger you dressed yourself ... where you wanted

but when you are old you will stretch out your hands, & someone else will dress you & lead you where you do not want to go."

19 Jesus said this to indicate the kind of DEATH by which Peter would glorify God.

Then Jesus said to Peter, "Follow Me!"
