Book of Judges ... Book of Tears

"Judges" comes from Shophetim, the title in the Hebrew Bible Shophetim comes from Shaphat Shaphat – to judge, discern, direct Shophetim are heads or chiefs of the Israelites who governed Israelite theocracy lasts about 350 years

Lasts from the death of Joshua to the death of Samson, or to the prophet Samuel

Ahhh ... 350 years ago was 1667


1666 GREAT FIRE of London devastated 13,000+ buildings!

Key Verse Judges 2:18

The Lord was moved to pity whenever they GROANED because of those who were oppressing and afflicting them.

You know that is true ... this verse comes to us AFTER telling a *history* of many TEARS ... see also Psalm 51:18 You will not reject a broken and repentant heart, O God.



Run, run, run ... look recap of history

¹ After the death of Joshua, the Israelites asked the LORD, "Who of us is to go up first to fight against the Canaanites?"

Men of Judah ask Simeonites ... LORD gave them Canaanites and

Perizzites – 10,000 men

Lion – Symbol of Judah

Gen. 49:9, Jacob:

Judah is a lion's whelp:

from the prey, my son, thou

art gone up: he stooped down,

he couched as a lion, and as an old lion;

who shall rouse him up?



1:1-36 Israel & Canaanite TOGETHER Summary

Lion is symbol on Ethiopian Flag

Also on the Imperial Flag of Emperor Haile Selassie

225th King from King David

Ethiopia believes their kings are successors of Menelik

Son of Solomon & Queen of Sheba

Heile Selassie started religion of Rastafarianism in Jamaica

Lot of Christian beliefs ...

Except Selassie is an incarnation of Christ

¹² Caleb gives daughter Aksah in marriage to Othniel for taking Kiriath Sepher / Debir

- > Otheniel is Caleb's nephew or
- > Othniel is Caleb's brother

Aksah – means "Anklet"

Aksah asked Daddy Othniel for a field ...

¹⁷ Judah & Simeonites attack Zephath, totally destroyed the city

18 Judah also took Gaza,
Ashkelon and Ekron ...

"The LORD was with them"

- ²⁰ Caleb gets Hebron ... drives out three sons of Anak.
- ²¹ Benjamites did NOT drive out the Jebusites
- ²² Tribes of Joseph attacked Bethel ...

The LORD was with them ...

23 Tribe of Joseph's spies ask man How do we get into your city?

Man tells the spies of Tribe of Joseph Tribe kills all, but save man & his family

Oh ... a lot of weeping ...

Yet ... most have a LOT of trouble!

- ²⁷ Manasseh did NOT drive people from 5 cities
- 29 Ephraim did NOT drive Canaanites from Gezer
- 30 Nor Zebulun ... from Kitron or Nahalol
- ³¹ Nor did Asher ... from 7 cities
- 32 Asherites lived among the Canaanites ... did NOT drive them out
- 33 Naphtali did NOT drive out the people from Beth Shemesh or Beth Anath ...



- 34 Amorites confined the Danites to the hill country, not allowing them to come down into the plain.
- 35 Amorites held out ... in Mount Heres, Aijalon and Shaalbim, but when ... tribes of Joseph increased ... Amorites enslaved

¹ Angel of the Lord went up from Gilgal to Bochim, said, "I brought you out of Egypt and led you into the land I had promised to your fathers."

I also said: I will never break My covenant with you.

Bochim – Place of Weeping ... or

Bochim – Place of Weepers

LXX – Septuagint – inserts "Bethel" Greek Trans. of O.T. Bible from 200 B.C.

But it's STRANGE that the Angel would TRAVEL to Bethel ...

Just don't know what to make of this ...

Where is the Place of Weepers?



2:1-10 **Angel of Lord @ Place of Weepers**

Angel of the Lord continues ... "God said ...

² Don't make a covenant with people ... tear down their altars ...

But you have not obeyed Me. What is this you have done?

"Angel of the Lord" appears 58x in O.T.

"Messenger of God" appears 9x in O.T.

Remember Joshua 5:14

Angel appears to Joshua as the

Commander of Lord's Army

2:1-10 Angel of Lord @ Place of Weepers

3 Therefore ... I will NOT drive out these people.... They will be thorns in your sides ... their gods will be a trap to you."

When the Angel of the Lord had spoken these words to all the Israelites, the people wept loudly.

Now ... listen to this ...

5 So they named that place Bochim and offered sacrifices there to the Lord.

At Gilgal, they call the place where the Angel stood the ...

Place of Weepers

vs. 2:1 was a historian writing after the fact ... perhaps



2:1-10 Angel of Lord @ Place of Weepers

⁶ Joshua sent the people away, and the Israelites went to take possession of the land, each to his own inheritance.

THEN ... they repeat Joshua 24:31 ... nearly

- ⁷ The people worshiped the Lord throughout Joshua's lifetime and during the lifetimes of the elders who outlived Joshua....
- ⁸ Joshua son of Nun, Servant of the Lord, died at the age of 110.
- ⁹ They buried him in the territory of his inheritance....

Then ... the rest of the story:

¹⁰ That whole generation was also gathered to their ancestors.

After them another generation rose up who did not know the Lord or the works He had done for Israel.

¹¹ The Israelites did what was evil in the Lord's sight. They worshiped the Baals

Notice as we begin the Lesson Verses

NARRATIVE or history is both ...

BEHIND ... and ... BEFORE us

Narrative BEHIND Judges 1:1 to 2:10

Narrative BEFORE Judges 3:1 to 21:21

Verses 2:11-23 is NOT a story ...
these are HEART ... the HEART of God

2:11-13 Abandonment – Worship Baals

¹¹ The Israelites did what was evil in the Lord's sight. They worshiped the Baals

¹² and abandoned the Lord, the God of their fathers, who had brought them out of Egypt.

They went after other gods from the surrounding peoples and bowed down to them.

They infuriated the Lord, ¹³ for they abandoned Him and worshiped Baal and the Ashtoreths.

Infuriated the Lord ...

NOT a good thing to do

Baal means lord, owner, possessor ... or or HUSBAND ...

Several cities used "Baal" as first part of name

Like Baal-peor or Baal-gad ...

Baal is a god that provides fertility ...

Fives miles northeast of Bethel is Baal-hazor

Baal of Hazor, seen in 2 Sam. 13:23 where David's son Absalom ambushed his brother Amnon who had raped his sister Tamar

Judges 2:11 says they worshiped Baals

There were many KINDS of Baals

Baal is often shown with a sister or consort

Baal can be seen in Satanic cults today, but that was NOT so in 1400 B.C.

They also worshiped Ashtoreths

In Greek, called Astarte

Female god of fertility, sexuality and war

Often, she is a wife or consort of Baal

Egyptians gave Astarte the title

"Lady of Heaven"

Babylonians & Assyrians called her Ashtar



Astarte with a horned headdress in the Louvre, Paris

2:11-13 Abandonment – Worship of Baals

After Alexander the Great, the Hellenists called her Aphrodite the Romans caller her Venus

The name "Canaan" ... goes way back
Canaanites – Canaan back to 2300 B.C.
Likely Canaan came from
"trader" or "merchant"

Aphrodite of the Syracuse type. Marble copy of the 2nd century CE after a Greek original of the 4th century BC



2:11-13 Abandonment – Worship Baals

2:13, They infuriated the Lord, ¹³ for they abandoned Him and worshiped Baal and the Ashtoreths.

It's hard to relate how Israel could this ...

Any thoughts on that?

How can we relate the "following after Gods" today?

From the time of Moses, the First Commandment

1400 B.C. Israelites ... to us today in 21st century

One easy way is to note ...

But is it that easy?

Are there other THINGS that compete?

Are there OTHER "gods" that compete?





2:14-15 Oppression – God Hands Them Over

¹⁴ The Lord's anger burned against Israel, and He handed them over to marauders who raided them. He sold them to the enemies around them, so that they could no longer resist their enemies.

15 Whenever the Israelites went out, the Lord was AGAINST them and brought disaster [on them], just as He had promised and sworn to them.

So they suffered greatly.

Rebellion ... SORT OF

Greatest offense is turning to OTHER gods!

2:16-19 Repentance – Lord Moved to Pity

¹⁶⁻¹⁷ Lord raised up judges, who saved them from the power of their marauders, but they did not listen to their judges. Instead, they prostituted themselves with other gods.... They quickly turned from the way of their fathers, who had walked in obedience to the Lord's commands. They did not do as their fathers did.

¹⁸ Whenever the Lord raised up a judge for the Israelites, the Lord was with him and saved the people from the power of their enemies while the judge was still alive. The Lord was moved to pity whenever they GROANED because of those who were oppressing and afflicting them.

¹⁹ Whenever the judge died, the Israelites would act even more corruptly than their fathers, going after other gods to worship and bow down to them. They did not turn from their [evil] practices or their obstinate ways.

2:16-19 Repentance – Lord Moved to Pity This is the INTRODUCTION to the Book of Judges ... The introduction to the Book of Tears ... Israel turns to other Gods ... God rejects Israel cries out, "Help us" ... God has pity, sends judge Judge dies ... Israel gets worse ... Worst of ALL is in Judges 19-21 2:1 Angel of the Lord went up from Gilgal to Bochim

When the Israelites heard the Angel ... they cried ... named the place

Place of the Weepers

Short statement by Angel ... but it hits HOME ... GOD is SPEAKING Israel KNOWS this is GOD ... so very, very, very personal ... They WEEP and CRY ... from profoundest sorrow

2:16-19 Repentance – Lord Moved to Pity

This is the INTRODUCTION to the Book of Judges ...

The introduction to the Book of Tears ...

Israel turns to other Gods ... God rejects

Israel cries out, "Help us" ... God has pity, sends judge

How can we PREVENT that today?

The passage does not really tell us directly ...

Oh, so much like God ... what the passage DOES TELL us ...

Is what GOD ALREADY told us

Like most of us ... we should not have to repeat ourselves God is truly a Jealous GOD ... no second place with God 2:16-19 Repentance – Lord Moved to Pity

Book of Judges ... the Book of Tears ...

Gives us SIX Cycles of Abandonment – Oppression – Repentance

Thirteen (13) Judges aid over 350 years ... very, long, long time

Many, many years & decades of oppression ...

If we apply a little math, here is what we get ...

- ≥ 350 ÷ 6 = 58 years for EACH whole 3-Phase Cycle
- > 58 ÷ 3 = 19 years for EACH Phase in the Cycle given SEVERAL of 13 Judges were near each other on timeline
- ➤ EASY to see that ONE single PHASE could be 20-35 years long

That is, an "Abandonment" could be 30 years in making ...

Or the "Oppression" could be 30-40 years long!

Book of Judges ... the Book of Tears

That is ... with only 13 Judges ... we will look at three

Over the course of 350 years ...

- 1. Abandonment
- 2. Oppression
- 6 full cycles ... each with 3 phases each 3. Repentance

We only have a FEW verses on 10 Judges—very few

Most of Judges, The Book of Tears, is on 3 Judges Deborah ... Gideon ... Samson

You KNOW what this means ... there are SIX 30-40-50-60-year periods of OPRESSION

Meaning 100s of 1,000s of stories of OPPRESSION

Meaning MILLIONS of Men, Women, Children ...
