






- ✓ SAMSON ... 20 years ALONE the LONELIEST JUDGE





What is important ... is that the Bible says:


SAMSON Loved Delilah

She did not SELL herself to SAMSON

What she did was actually worse ...

Delilah SOLD the man who LOVED her

Few betrayals can be worse ...

This is TREASON of the heart - universally despised

Key Verse Judges 16:20

But he did not know that the LORD had left him



SAMSON & Delilah ... betrayal in plain site

Dante Alighieri made TREASON FAMOUS

His epic 1555 poem, Divine Comedy


3 sections: 1. Inferno or Hell

- 2. Purgatory
- 3. Paradise

Inferno-Hell has 9 Concentric Circles

Each circle going deeper & deeper as degrees "wrongs" increase through 9 levels of evil

So too the punishments increase



Inferno-Hell's 9 Circles - Dante is guided down by Virgil

1st Limbo 5th Wrath

2nd Lust 6th Heresy

3rd Gluttony 7th Violence

4th Greed 8th Fraud

9th Circle - TREACHERY

There in Hell's

lowest CENTER

we find Satan

9th Circle - TREACHERY has 4 regions ... increasing

1st Treachery against Kindred - named Caina for Cain who slew Able

2nd Treachery against Country - named Antenora for the Trojan the betrayed Troy


3rd Treachery against Guests - named Ptolomaea invited, killed his father-in-law

4th Treachery against Lords – named Judecca for Judas who betrayed Jesus

Center of Hell is Satan ... chewing on Judas & two others

Hell's deepest parts ... are reserved for

13:2, Man named Manoah ("REST") of Zorah of the Danites with a barren wife

Zorah – aprox 20 miles from Jerusalem

Originally given to Judah, but had since become part of Dan


Zorah is on a sharp-pointed conical hill

overlooking the Valley of Sorek

Zorah is 1,100 feet above sea level, with a gentle slope to the northeast


Josephus (A.D. 37-100), a Jewish-Roman Historian said


Manoah & wife were very esteemed, of high rank, of influence in Philistia & Israel

Manoah was of impeccable virtue and his wife very beautiful

Matthew Arnold (1822-88), great literary critic, poet and professor at Oxford, said:

"The story of Samson, although it has no mystery or complication to inspire, like tragic stories of the most perfect kind, a fore boding and anxious gloom in the mind of him who hears it, is yet a truly dramatic and noble one."







5-7, She tells husband about the "awesome man"

They later understand as an Angel

Samson – to be a Nazirite of God from the womb until the day of his death

First and only Nazirite to be such all of his life

Nazirite Vow

- √ From "nazir" meaning consecrated or separated
- ✓ Numbers 6:2-21 gives rules of essentially three-fold vow:
 - 1. No wine of any kind or even non-fermented grapes
 - 2. No cutting hair
 - 3. No contact with corpses or graves
- ✓ Made by verbal declaration: "I am a Nazirite for 1 yr" or "forever"
- ✓ Three kinds of Nazirite:
 - 1. Set time, after which one gives several offerings & shaves head but if temple is not there, de facto permanent
 - 2. Permanent "I am a Nazirite for life"
 - 3. Like Samson "I am a Nazirite like Samson"

2:12-36 Eli's sons scoundrels - Samuel blessed - Eli's end

Nazirite Vow

- ✓ None before Samson in the Bible, but seems evident before Moses
- ✓ Only three in Scripture who were Nazirites
 - 1. Samson in Judges 13:4
 - 2. Samuel in 1 Samuel 1:11
 - 3. John the Baptist in Luke 1:15
- ✓ Paul took a Nazirite vow in Acts 21, as it was allowed for one to "join others" in their vow

Samson & Samuel dedicated as such by their Mothers


13:18-19, Angels sets Manoah's offering on fire, then in the flame the Angel ascends to heaven

Strangely ...

SAMSON never gets to see an Angel

SAMSON has no Prophet to help him

SAMSON grows up without much of any guidance ...

13:21-25, Manoah & wife SEE ... man was an ANGEL

Manoah cries, "We're doomed to die!" he said to his wife.

"We have seen God!"

They realize they have been talking to an Angel ...

Apparently, they had not seen many angels

About 4 miles between


Below Zorah is the Valley of Sorek

14:1-20, Samson likes woman in Timnah Timnah is aprox. 10 miles west of Zorah Border town to Philistine Territory Father and Mother wish not, but Lord was working ...

SAMSON goes with Father & Mother
Near a vineyard, SAMSON meets a lion
SAMSON tears the Lion to pieces
Passages does not say merely "kill"
SAMSON tore the Lion apart ...

Judges 15:20 says **SAMSON** judged Israel 20 years

did PRAY & God Helped


Goes without saying ...

SAMSON just goes to work day after day


Job? = Fighting & Humiliating Philistines

Shares Honey with Mom & Dad

But does NOT share where he got the honey


Not sure I would like honey from ... what?

SAMSON - the PLAYFUL!

SAMSON offers a RIDDLE

30 garments for me if you CANNOT solve the riddle

30 garments to you if you CAN

30 Men say, "Okey Dokey" Maness Loose-leaf translation

The Riddle:

"Out of the eater, something to eat; out of the strong, something sweet."



SAMSON – the RIDDLER

On the 4th day of the feast 30 men coax his wife to coax SAMSON

14:16, SAMSON's wife threw herself on him, sobbing, "You hate me! You don't really love me...."

14:17, She cried the whole seven days of the feast.

SAMSON told her ...



SAMSON – the KIND

30 Men come before sundown on the 7th day of the feast ...

"What is sweeter than honey? What is stronger than a lion?" SAMSON said,

"If you had not plowed with my heifer, you would not have solved my riddle."

Don't believe SAMSON was ignorant of wife's weakness

You've GOT to know that SAMSON knew a little of the 30 crafting & plotting



SAMSON – the PERCEPTIVE

SAMSON kept secrets from his parents ...

I suspect he KNEW the pressure she was facing ...

and ...

For HER sake ... told her

For HER sake ... so she could save face before her people ...

Whatever ...

SAMSON was unafraid ...




SAMSON – the GENEROUS!

SAMSON – Spirit of the Lord on him

SAMSON goes down to Ashkelon
Timnah to Ashkelon about 30 miles
SAMSON struck down 30 Philistines
Gave clothes to 30 men in Timnah
SAMSON went home to Zoroah ANGRY

Samson's wife given to one of his companions at the feast.

SAMSON – Man of His WORD



SAMSON returns for wife

Father ... ooops ... had given her away

SAMSON catches 300 foxes, ties them into pairs ... sets tails on fire

Looses them into grain fields, vinyards and olive groves ... burns all ...

Philistines burn Timnite father & daughter

SAMSON, "Okay," kills many viciously

Don't mess with SAMSON!

SAMSON goes to Cave at Rock of Etam between Bethlehem & Tekoa



SAMSON – the **VENGEFUL?**

or

SAMSON – the JUDGE

Philistines go to men of Judah

"Why?" men of Judah ask

Philistines, "To take SAMSON prisoner!"

3,000 men of Judah go to SAMSON

Plead case ... "Don't you know that the

Philistines are our RULERS?"

SAMSON thought, NOT MINE!

SAMSON says, "Okey dokey, as long you DON'T kill me yourselves."

"DEAL," said the men of Judah
Men of Judah bind SAMSON &
escort to the rock at Lehi



SAMSON – the MERCIFUL

Just as he did with his wife, allowing the ruse of the 30 ...

SAMSON *allowed* the men of Judah to BIND him

BOUND on the Rock of Lehi ... alone


SAMSON sees the Philistines and waits


Philistines shout ... yippee!

Grabs the jawbone ... KILLS 1,000






Samson Slays 1000, 1860 by Julius Schnorr von Carolsfeld (1794-1872)

To the Philistines ... a clear message


➢ God is WITH SAMSON ...

Then, so thirsty, famished, he feared he'd be killed

16:1, One day Samson went to Gaza, where he saw a prostitute. He went in to spend the night with her


Today: Palestinian Gaza Strip

16 SAMSON and Delilah

SAMSON lay still to middle of the night

Oh, how sly the city folk THINK they are ...

SAMSON, merciful to city people

Truly, if he can take 1,000 soldiers, how easy it would be to take out mere city folk?

16:3, SAMSON got up and took hold of the doors of the city gate, together with the two posts, and tore them loose, bar and all.

He lifted them to his shoulders and carried them to the top of the hill that faces Hebron.

Merciful to city folk in Gaza






16 SAMSON and Delilah

Robert Southwell wrote:

"Her little sweet hath many sours, **Short haps immortal harms;**

Her loving looks are murdering darts, Her songs bewitching charms"


Delilah, "languishing" or "weakened"

Because of SAMSON's previous visits to a prostitute ...

Common to assume Delilah was too

But ... not necessarily

SAMSON did fall in LOVE ...

SAMSON fell in LOVE with Delilah Philistines began working on Delilah

There's a case that SAMSON had good, tender feelings for the weak

Delilah's name DOES mean "languishing" or "weakened"

What we ALL dislike is TREACHERY

So very, very little of 20 years

16 SAMSON and Delilah

Obvious to all—Delilah didn't love SAMSON as we expect

She DID SELL him out ...

Remember, Delilah "the weak"

this was a time when

Women were GIVEN away

Headstrong women—RARE!

I believe SAMSON a wise Judge

I think Delilah had some GENUINE affection for him & he FELT that

Five Frantic Philistine Kings offer 1,100 pieces of silver EACH

Herbert Wolf est. 1,100 pieces @ 140 lbs


- \geq 5,500 pieces of silver = 700 lbs
- \triangleright today's \$17.60 an oz. = \$197,120

K. L. Younger said it was THEN an "absurdly fantastic amount" 550x above aver. annual wage

Meaning, if aver. is \$25,000 today

Meaning, the Frantic Philistine Kings offered Delilah \$2,500,000!





Because the text is so CLIPPED, it is likely this was over several days


EACH time—each time, the Philistines HID in the next room!

EACH time, SAMSON went to sleep!

Says a LOT about SAMSON's courage, fearlessness & utter CONFIDENCE

He STILL slept the 2nd & 3rd times!

They were AFRAID of him ASLEEP



SAMSON the FEARLESS 4th, TRUTH ... cut my hair

WHY? ...

WHY? ... he KNEW Delilah was WEAK

SAMSON ... he KNEW enemies hid

SAMSON ... he KNEW ... and STILL he slept!

WHY? ... Delilah cried, whined ... and whined day after day ...

WHY? ... why STAY when you KNOW?

Some suggest he was TIRED of all and just wanted to live a normal life

Be a regular Joe w the woman he loved

WHY? ... was he seduced? ... not really

WHY? ... one reason ... hard to see




WHY? ... we do not know for sure
God knows ... but we can scratch a bit
In all the Bible ... we have no indication

- ✓ IF Israel EVER truly appreciated
- ✓ IF ANYONE ever said "thank you"

- ✓ IF ANYONE ever TRULY, honestly, with their heart of hearts ...


Truly LOVED SAMSON

He loved ... his parents & Israel & God
Perhaps he loved his 1st wife in Timnah
Cared a bit for weak city folk in GAZA
who knew NOT how merciful he was
when he took their gate, not their lives



And SAMSON loved Delilah ... Delilah, whose name meant "WEAK" For 20 years, there is NO indication That ISRAEL had any REAL problems He PLACED his LIFE in Delilah's hand And then he ... went to SLEEP Selah ...





Philistines came ...

They gouged OUT his eyes

Took him to the prison at GAZA

Tasked SAMSON to grind wheat

The Philistines praised DAGON

The LORD had left SAMSON

As a driver walked slowly behind, WHIPPING the back of SAMSON

Perhaps Samson said in a loud voice.

"Eloi Eloi lama sabachthani?"*


Samson Grinding at Prison in Gaza by William Brassey Hole (1846-1917)

Philistines paraded SAMSON Philistines humiliated SAMSON Children threw food at him Old soldiers spit on him They laughed ... ate ... drank God was watching ... **Nothing, nothing God hates more** Than ANYONE worshipping idols God watched ... and watched ... SAMSON asked for help to find the PILLARS He would like to LEAN on the PILLARS



SAMSON ... prayed for the first time That he would be given strength SAMSON shoved with all his might His last words,


"Let me die with the Philistines."

Buried with his father, Manoah

Why did he yield, surrender to Delilah?

We will never know for certain ...

But that 4th time ... was NOT merely because of HER persuasions ...

SAMSON was tired and could NOT ...

SAMSON could not leave her ...

- No matter how TRAITORUS the betrayal
- No matter how BAD the consequences



Of all SAMSON's strengths

To the very end ... no matter

Delilah, the weak, no matter how much she MAY have liked him

SAMSON ... could NOT

SAMSON ... would **NOT**


