





- 9:22-24 Blessing Moses/Aaron Bless ... God's Fire Consumes
  - 10:1-3 Holy Nadab & Abihu ... Consumed by God's Fire
- ✓ Priesthood THEN mediated God GRACE & GLORY to people
- ✓ Today ... WE are each his or her own PRIEST ...
- **✓ Each one of us in & through Christ COME TO GOD THE FATHER**







- 5:14 LORD said to Moses ... more
- 6:1 LORD said to Moses ... more
- 6:8 LORD said to Moses ... more
- 6:19 LORD said to Moses ... more
- 6:24 LORD said to Moses ... more
- 7:22 LORD said to Moses ... more
- 7:28 Lord said to Moses ... more
- 7:35-38 ... these are the regulations



After 1-7 on the Five Main Offerings ... leading to Chapter 9

Chapters 8-9 ... Aaron & Sons inducted into the Priesthood

8:1, The LORD said to Moses ...

Bring Aaron and Sons

8:4-36, narrative—Moses does ALL

- ✓ Brings Aaron & Sons
- ✓ Dresses them
- ✓ Anoints them
- √ Sacrifices for them

## 8:36 closes with:

So Aaron and his sons did EVERYTHING the LORD commanded through Moses.



Chapter 9 opens with Moses speaking

Calling Aaron & Sons together on the EIGHTH DAY

Aaron & Sons have a job to do

9:6 Then Moses said,
"This is what the LORD has
commanded you to do,
so that the glory of the LORD
may appear to you."

9:7-14, Aaron & Sons slay a calf

- ✓ For sin offering for himself
- ✓ Bring Moses the blood
- ✓ Blood on horns ... at base

**NEXT ... Sacrifice for the PEOPLE** 



## So then ... Aaron sacrifices for the people

- Aaron then brought the offering that was for the people. He took the goat for the people's sin offering and slaughtered it and offered it for a sin offering as he did with the first one.
- <sup>16</sup> He brought the burnt offering and offered it in the prescribed way.
- <sup>17</sup> He also brought the grain offering, took a handful of it and burned it on the altar in addition to the morning's burnt offering.

## 2. Love Others

Several verses in the New Testament that speak to taking care of the Household of Faith

1 & 2 Corinthians are masterpieces

Hardly needs saying that to Love Others WELL



LOVE

GOD

First

Aaron sacrifices ... for himself FIRST

Makes Atonement for himself FIRST

Then in our passage of the hour

THEN ... Aaron sacrifices for the people

- 1. Love God
- 2. Love Others

In other words

- 1. Get Right with God FIRST
- 2. Help Others Better

Principles reinforced throughout the N.T.



In other words

Your LIFE before God comes first

2 Corinthians 2:15-16

For we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved AND among those who are perishing.

<sup>16</sup> To the one we are an aroma that brings death;

to the other, an aroma that brings life.

And who is equal to such a task?

Ohhh—overall message of ALL the sacrifices is:



LOVE

GOD

First

Hebrews 9 goes to GREAT lengths

To show how Christ fulfilled the LAW

Heb. 9 reaches back to Leviticus 17:11

<sup>11</sup> For the life of a creature is in the blood, and I have given it to you to make atonement for yourselves on the altar;

it is the *BLOOD* that makes atonement for one's *LIFE*.

Leviticus 17:11 is widely regarded as the most definitive statement on the BLOOD

That is ... on the BLOOD that is SHED



Hebrews 9 goes to GREAT lengths

To show how Christ fulfilled the LAW


After author of Hebrews introduces Moses

Hebrews 9:19-21, Moses saying:

<sup>20</sup> "This is the blood of the covenant, which God has commanded you to keep."

21 In the same way, he sprinkled with the BLOOD on both the tabernacle and everything used in its ceremonies.

In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with BLOOD, and without the shedding of BLOOD there is NO FORGIVENESS.



Author of Hebrews goes on in splendid, even spectacular revelations ...


In Hebrews 12, the author leads to Moses

Hebrews 12:18-24,

18 You have not come to a mountain that can be touched and that is BURNING WITH FIRE; to darkness, gloom and storm;

to a trumpet blast or to such a voice speaking words that those who heard it begged that no further word be spoken to them,

<sup>20</sup> because they could not bear what was commanded: "If even an animal touches the mountain, it must be stoned to death."



NO SIR ... NO Ma'am ...

In Christ, you have NOT come to the Untouchable Mountain

Hebrews 12:18-24, No Sir ... No Ma'am

<sup>21</sup> The sight was so terrifying that Moses said, "I am trembling with fear."

But you have come to Mount Zion,
 to the city of the living God,
 the heavenly Jerusalem.
 You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly,

Yes ... then, the feared Untouchable Mountain



NO SIR ... NO Ma'am ...

In Christ, you have COME the BEST, even

Mount Zion

Hebrews 12:18-24, more than Mt. Zion:

to the church of the firstborn,
 whose names are written in heaven.
 You have come to God, the Judge of all,
 to the spirits of the righteous made perfect,

<sup>24</sup> to Jesus the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled BLOOD that speaks a better word than the BLOOD of Abel.

Our inheritance ... bought with BLOOD ...



Mount Zion ...

**Settled by King David ...** 

Temple built by his son, King Solomon

Visited by Jesus ... who would care for them as a hen would her chicks

Crucified ... the Last Sacrifice ...


His BLOOD to cover our transgressions

Raised on the third day ... ascended

We Have a New Mount Zion

**Untouchable Mountain** 



## So then ... Aaron sacrifices for the people

<sup>18</sup> He slaughtered the ox and the ram as the fellowship offering for the people. His sons handed him the BLOOD, and he splashed it against the sides of the altar.

19-20 But the fat portions of the ox and the ram—the fat tail, the layer of fat, the kidneys and the long lobe of the liver—these they laid on the breasts, and then Aaron burned the fat on the altar.

<sup>21</sup> Aaron waved the breasts and the right thigh before the LORD as a wave offering, as Moses commanded.



Lev. 9:22-24 Blessing – Moses/Aaron Bless ... God's Fire Consumes


#### **Now notice Aaron**

Then Aaron lifted his hands toward the people and blessed them. And having sacrificed the Sin Offering, the Burnt Offering and the Fellowship Offering, he stepped down.

Next ... a Private Time with the LORD

Moses and Aaron then went into the tent of meeting. When they came out, they blessed the people; and the GLORY OF THE LORD appeared to all the people.

Glory of the LORD



Lev. 9:22-24 Blessing – Moses/Aaron Bless ... God's Fire Consumes

Next ... the fire

Fire came out from the presence of the LORD and consumed the Burnt Offering and the fat portions on the altar.

And when all the people saw it, they shouted for joy and fell facedown.

With the fire ... ALL consumed

All forgiven ... pointing to Christ

Though Israel did not yet know!

**But GOD Knew** 



Lev. 10:1-3 Holy – Nadab & Abihu ... Consumed by God's Fire

### Out of rebellion come two sons

Aaron's sons Nadab and Abihu took their censers, put fire in them and added incense; and they offered UNAUTHORIZED FIRE before the LORD, contrary to his command.

<sup>2</sup> So fire came out from the presence of the LORD and consumed them,

and

they died before the LORD.



Lev. 10:1-3 Holy - Nadab & Abihu ... Consumed by God's Fire

### In conclusion

Moses then said to Aaron, "This is what the LORD spoke of when he said: "Among those who approach me I will be proved holy; in the sight of all the people I will be honored."

Last part of verse 3

**Aaron remained silent.** 

fearful thing to trifle with God's LAW
