1-3 An Empty Tomb – early, stone rolled, no body and nobody Luke 24:1-3

On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.



Greeks and Romans Resurrection

- + Greeks believed in immortality of sorts, shadowlike in Hades
- Greeks believed some heroes could go to Elysian Fields, a place separate from Hades
- Or to the Fortunate Isles or Isles of the Blessed, or a lucky few could arrive at the place of Gods, as they believe Hercules did
- Greeks and Romans believed there was no return from death
- * Necromancy one could communicate with the dead ... a little

Parthenon in Athens finished 437 B.C.



RESURRECTION Jews

- Sadducees not believe in resurrection, soul dying with body
- Hellenized Jews (being Platonic) believed in a higher life, even a disembodied soul
- Pharisees believed in an afterlife, not another life, death's destruction, a place where the justice of God is served














Herod Antipas – 20 B.C. to A.D. 39

Tatian 1488-1576 considered the greatest Venetian artist

1512 – *Noli me tangere*, Latin for "don't touch me," from John 20:17, what Jesus said to Mary Magdalene after his resurrection.


"Don't touch me," became popular figure of speech in Gregorian chants in the Middle Ages.
