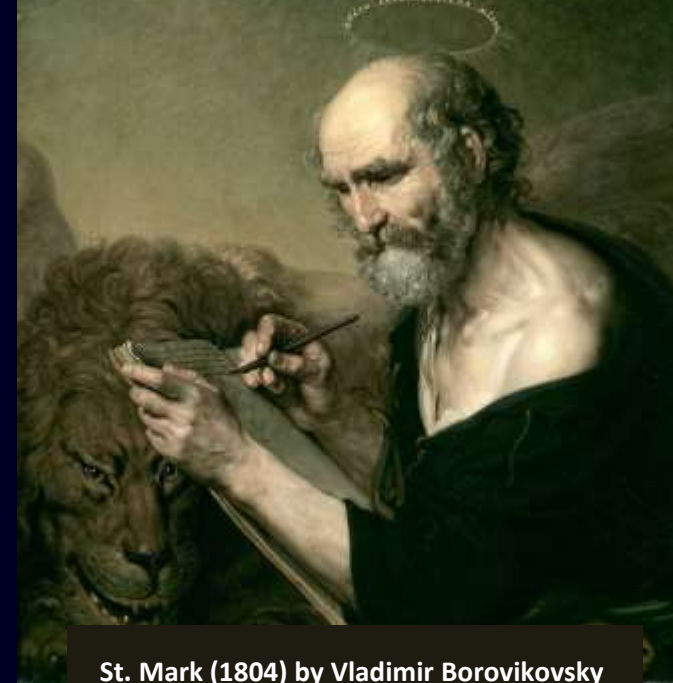

Mark Chapter 15 encloses all **14 Stages** ... w the rest of the Bible  
There are 100s of renditions of the **14 Stages**  
There are PARKS with statues rendering the **14 Stages**

- 11th Station: Jesus Is Nailed to the Cross
- 12th Station: Jesus Dies on the Cross
- 13th Station: Jesus' Body Removed from the Cross

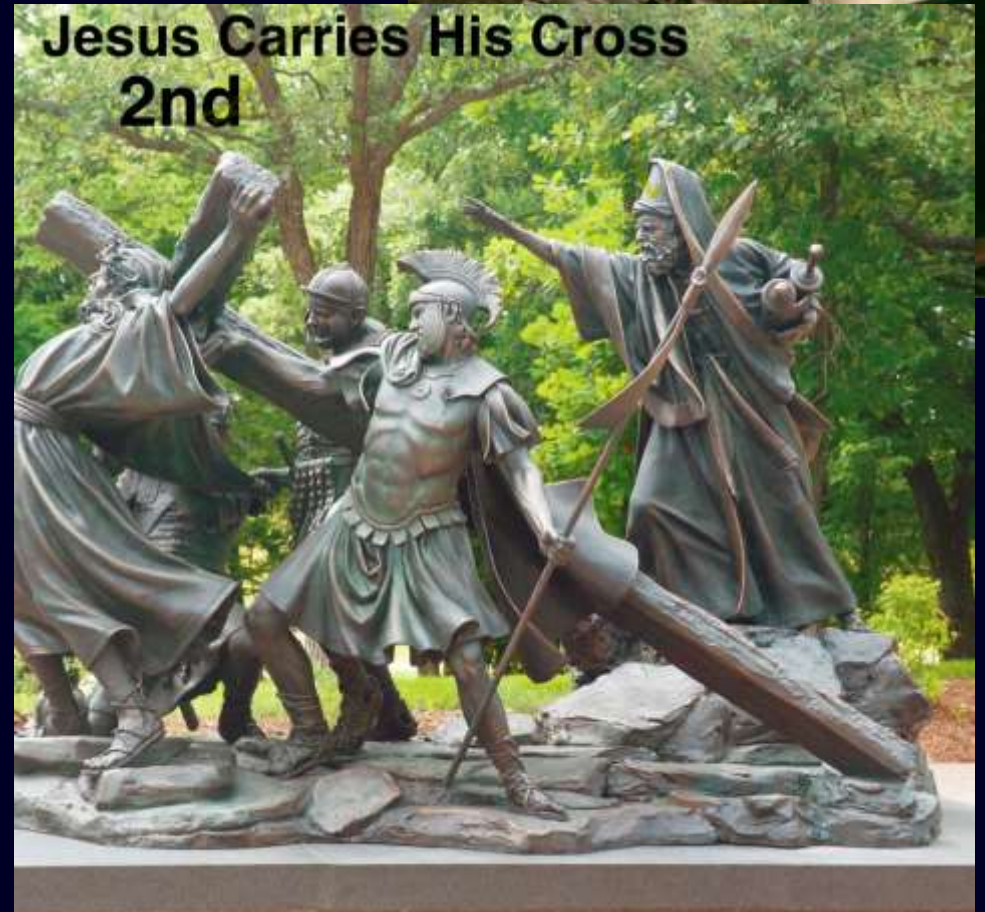

**Become Friends**





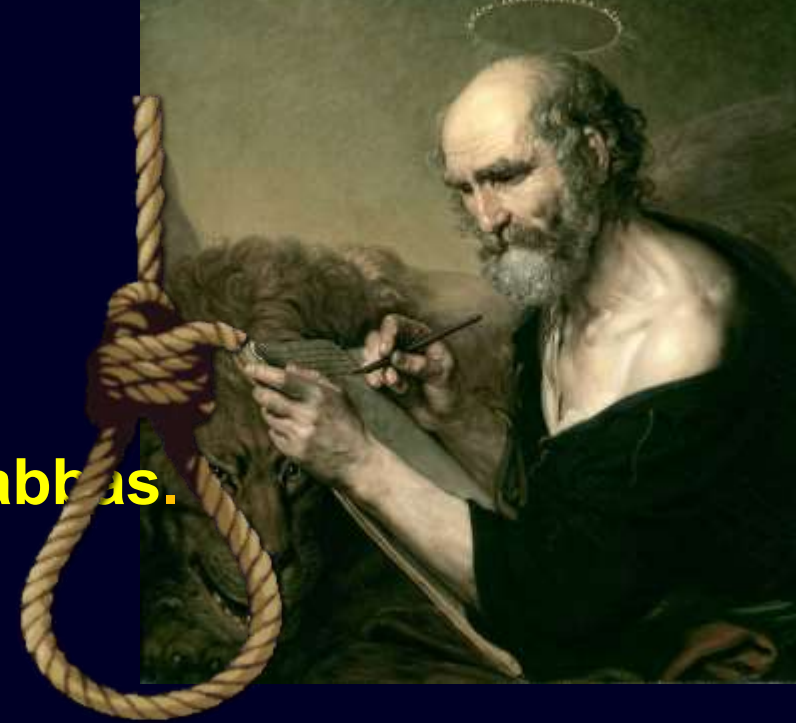

Then he rolled a stone against the entrance of the tomb.

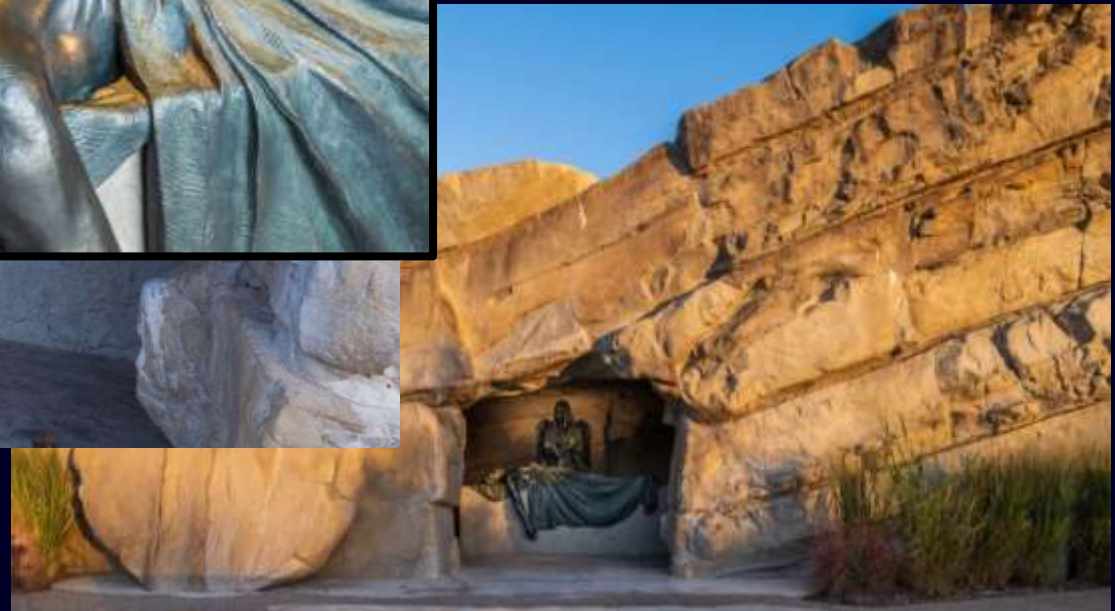
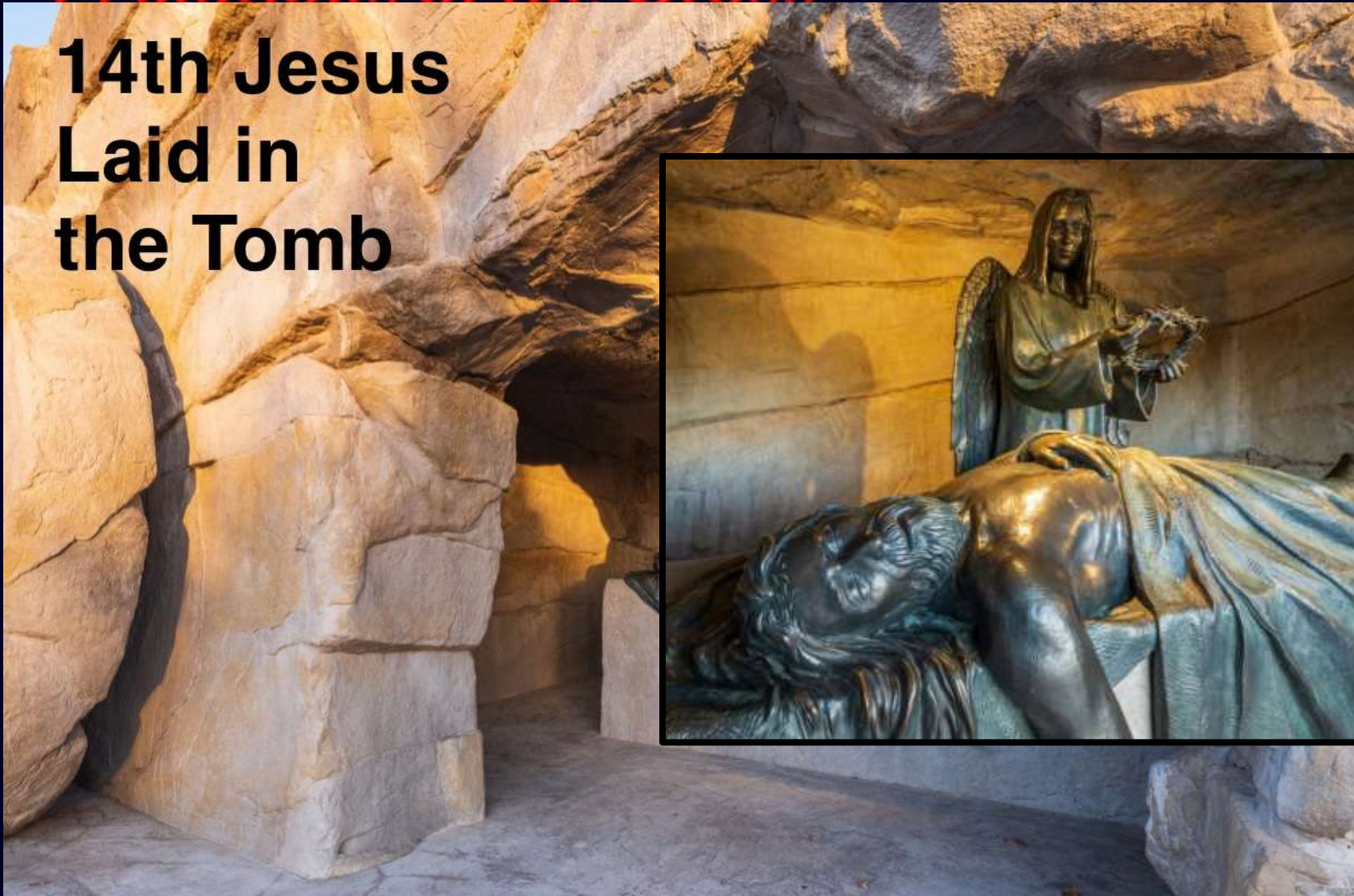
