

Matthew 1-4 – Affirming Jesus' Royalty???

We do not normally think of Jesus as having “Royal Blood”

We do not like “Royal Blood” –

“Royal Blood” is the ultimate in **UNMERITED FAVOR**

“Royal Blood” is the ultimate Dismissal – *ALL others LESS THAN*


“Royal Blood” has always been a scam to Americans

Only Jesus’ blood connected to God’s promises

 matters to us “Christians”

Jesus is the **ONLY King of Merit**

- ✓ **ONLY King to whom we bow**
- ✓ **ONLY King who LOVES us**
- ✓ **ONLY King who's inheritance we *SHARE***

Emperor – Tyrant – Ruler – Pharaoh – Warlord





Sea of Galilee lowest freshwater lake in world

- ✓ **Around 700 feet below sea level**
- ✓ **About 13 miles long & 8 miles wide**
- ✓ **About 140 feet deep**
- ✓ **Fed mainly by Jordan River & a little by springs**

**Matthew 1:1 - This is the genealogy of Jesus Christ
the son of David, the son of Abraham....**

Greek “Christou” = Christ, found **254x** in N.T. of **538x** in 5 variations
sometimes “Christou” is translated as “Messiah” = “Anointed One”
– CHRIST is the equivalent of the O.T. Hebrew MESSIAH

1:1-17 gives 14 generations, then the CHRISTMAS STORY

18 – Joseph finds Mary pregnant and loves her
to NOT follow the law & STONE HER

19 **Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the LAW,
and yet DID NOT want to expose her to public disgrace,
he had in mind to divorce her quietly.**

Deuteronomy is **STILL** the rock of Jews & Joseph
And Joseph did NOT want to follow the LAW



Matthew 3 – John the Baptist Baptizes Jesus

Matthew describes John the Baptist as

Voice Crying in the Wilderness *quoting Is. 40:3*

Then Jesus comes to John to be baptized

3:16-17 As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on Him.

Voice from heaven said, “This is my Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased.”









Matthew 4:1-11 – Satan Tempts Jesus

After 40 days fasting, the “**tempter**” came & asked:

Devil – διαβόλου ~ diabalou ~ diabolical ~ N.T. 13x among 38 uses in 6 variations, always translated **DEVIL**

Tempter – 4x in 38 uses in 21 variations – “tempting one”

as in Matt 22:35 **One of them, an expert in the law,**
[same word] **TESTED Him with this question...**

Satan – լե-սա-տան – 27x in O.T., sometimes God’s angel

Numbers 22:22, **the angel of the LORD stood in the way for an ADVERSARY against him.**

16x **haś-սա-տան** - 14x in Job, 2x in Zechariah

Of course, the most definitive reference is Job 1:16

One day the angels came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came with them.


Jesus again quotes the Law—Deuteronomy 6:16

Temptation 3 – Who Is YOUR King?


Finally, on the 3rd try, Satan reveals his True Self






