Matthew, Mark relate the Angel telling the women to tell the disciples Jesus is on His way to Galilee

Mark says Jesus appears to two walking in the country


Luke says the TWO were on the way to Emmaus ... 20 miles EAST of Jerusalem

I think that is a LONGER way to Galilee

Going up through Samaria instead of down the Jericho Road and up the Jordan River

Luke records a LONG talk by Jesus to the two Emmaus disciples... then POOF!







Mark mentions a short version of the Great Commission

Then straight to the Ascension

From Mark, we assume that the Ascension took place in Galilee

From Matthew & Mark, Jesus appears to Disciples in Galilee

ABSENCE of travel back down to Bethany and Jerusalem

Luke is clear, Ascension is *near Bethany*

"Appearing" in Matthew in Galilee ... Described by John at great length

John 21:9, When they landed, they saw a fire of burning coals there with fish on it, and some bread.


Ahhhh ... the Lord's Fish Fry

Now this was AFTER appearance to the men on the Road to Emmaus What?—Road to Emmaus? ON THE ROAD to where? Where did Jesus go after that? Next we find Jesus on the mountain And likely BEFORE Jesus appears to them on the shore of Galilee On the Road to Emmaus ...

About 20 miles from Jerusalem to Emmaus






Road to Emmaus, c. 1650 by Roelant Roghman (1627-92)

Eat with Jesus at Emmaus Their HEARTS were WARMED What did that FEEL like? I suspect it felt – SAFE I suspect it felt – COZY I suspect it felt – CONFIDENT Void of Confusion ... Earthy Then ... they SAW ... JESUS! Poof ... Jesus disappears ...

Sometime after Emmaus ... Jesus caught up with the Disciples at "Dah Mountain"

Matt. 17:1 ... Jesus took Peter, James, and his brother John, and led them up on a high mountain by themselves.


Mountain of Transfiguration Perhaps Same as Matthew 28

Matt. 17, from Caesarea Philippi, Jesus's Inner Circle heads to a HIGH MOUNTAIN


Tradition has it as Mt. Tabor, 1,886 feet


Yet, "HIGH" at 9,232 feet is Mt. Hermon

After Phillipi, did they travel to Mt. Tabor, some 80+ miles and several days?



There are cases, or guesses, for 4 other "Mountains"





Mt. Tabor, eastern edge of Valley of Jezreel, or Har-Meggido

Jezreel Valley or Valley of Har-Meggido

If you look close ... at Mt. Tabor I think you can see a church Back then ... EVERYONE knew where Mt. Tabor

Mt. Tabor by Catherine Tobin, 1855

1912 Mt. Tabor, viewed from Mt. Carmel in northwest corner of eastern edge of Valley of Jezreel, or Har-Meggido

By 12th century, Mt. Tabor was believed the Mt. of Transfiguration

Top is almost 1,886 feet above the Valle of Jezreel or Har-Meggido

During 2nd Temple 516 B.C.- A.D. 70 a light beacon on top notified northern tribes of feast days and new months ...

You could hear the Shofar a very long way from Mt. Tabor



¹⁶ The ELEVEN disciples traveled to Galilee, to Dah Mountain ... Jesus had directed them.

¹⁷ When they SAW HIM, they worshiped, but some doubted.


Jesus APPEARED to them ??


John notes how Jesus cooked for them while they were in the boat ...

They enjoy the Jesus' Fish Fry ...


John 21:14, This was now the third time Jesus appeared to his disciples after he was raised from the dead.

Next on "Dah Mountain," perhaps Mr. Tabor John does NOT reveal any commission or even the ascension of Christ







John ends with them on the shore of Galilee


"Peter, do you love me?" asked Jesus.

John closes with this:

John 21:25 Jesus did many other things as well. If every one of them were written down, I suppose that even the whole world would not have room for the books that would be written.

When was the Great Commission given? Perhaps BEFORE Jesus' Seashore Sermon What a time ... what a place ...

Perhaps, before the Great Fish Fry Somewhere on Mt.. Tabor, Jesus comes ¹⁷ When they saw Him, they worshiped, but some doubted. I suspect ... same place Jesus took

them the year before in Matt 17 when he was transfigured

That is a statement ... a claim ... **Do you remember Gethsemane?** Do you remember Jesus before ... **Mighty High Priest & his hangmen** Remember ALL that Jesus said that STUNG the Priests to their core That SHOCKED the disciples ... Now ... after the Resurrection ... After hearing the women ...

Spurgeon ... poetic on the Resurrection

- Dwell with your hearts very much upon Christ crucified
- But indulge yourselves full often with a sight of Christ glorified
- Delight to think that He is not here, for He is risen!
- He is not here, for He has ascended!
- He is not here, for He sits at the right hand of God, and makes intercession for us!

Now Jesus approaches them ...

Let your souls travel frequently the blessed highway from the sepulcher to the throne.

Ah ... stupendous ...

The way to His throne was downward! Mounting upon steps of ivory, Solomon ascended to his throne of gold; but our Lord and Master *descended* that He might *ascend*, and went down into the awful deeps of unutterable agony

Omnipotence = Latin for "all power."

to describe infinity, or

Or map the boundless as to tell what "ALL POWER" must mean. Whatever it is, it is all given to our Lord, All lodged in those hands which once were fastened to the wood of shame; All left with that heart which was pierced with the spear;

All placed as a crown upon that head which was surrounded with a coronet of thorns.

"ALL POWER IN HEAVEN" is His! "Remember that!" hails Spurgeon.

Then He has the power of *God,* for God is in heaven, and the power of God emanates from that central throne!

Jesus, then, has divine power;

Whatever Jehovah can do, Jesus can do! Selah ...

expositions as these defy our normal sense – *Thank You,* Mighty Spurgeon But just a tad more …

If it were His will to speak another world into existence,

We should see, tonight, a fresh star adorning the brow of night! Were it His will, at once, to fold up creation like a worn-out vesture, Io, the elements would pass away, and yonder heavens would be shriveled like a scroll!

The power which binds the sweet influences of the Pleiades, and loosens the bands of Orion is with the Nazarene!

The crucified leads forth Arcturus with his sons!

and cherubim and seraphim, and the four living creatures before the throne unceasingly obey Him!

He who was despised and rejected of men now commands the homage of all heaven, ALL HEAVEN as "God over all, blessed forever."

and life to all existence!

Old heathen dreamed of Apollo as driving the chariot of the sun, and guiding its fiery steeds in their daily course,


