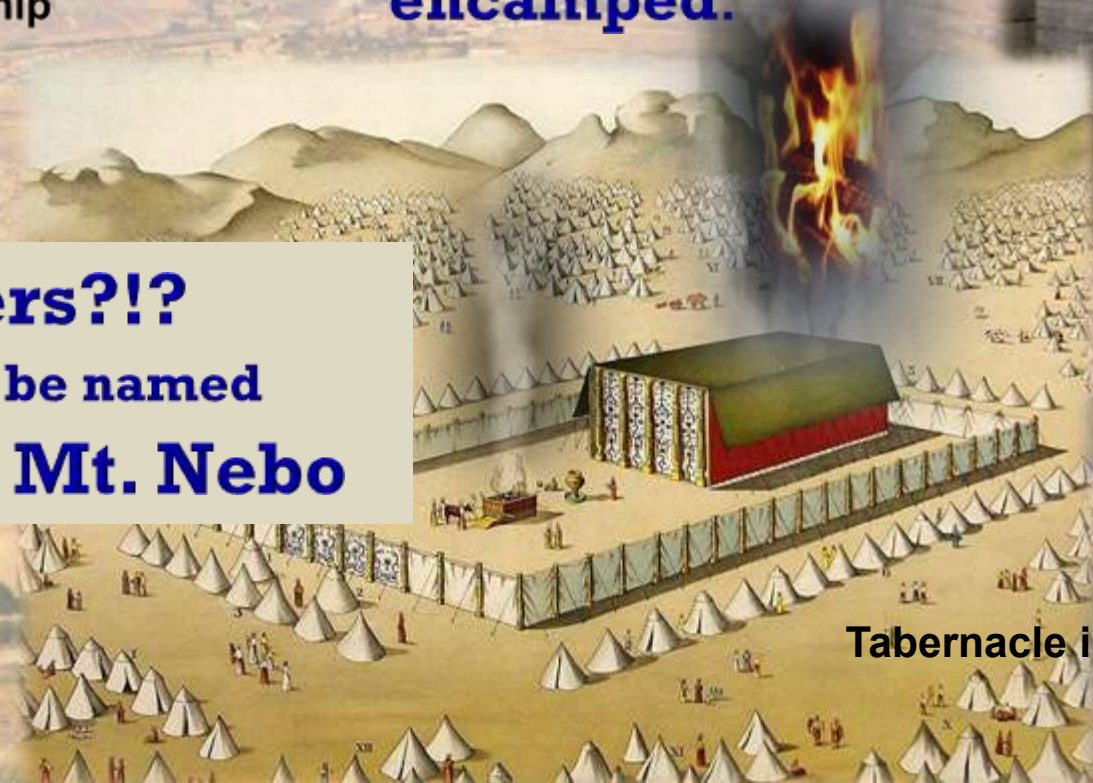

There the LORD showed him the whole land—from Gilead to Dan

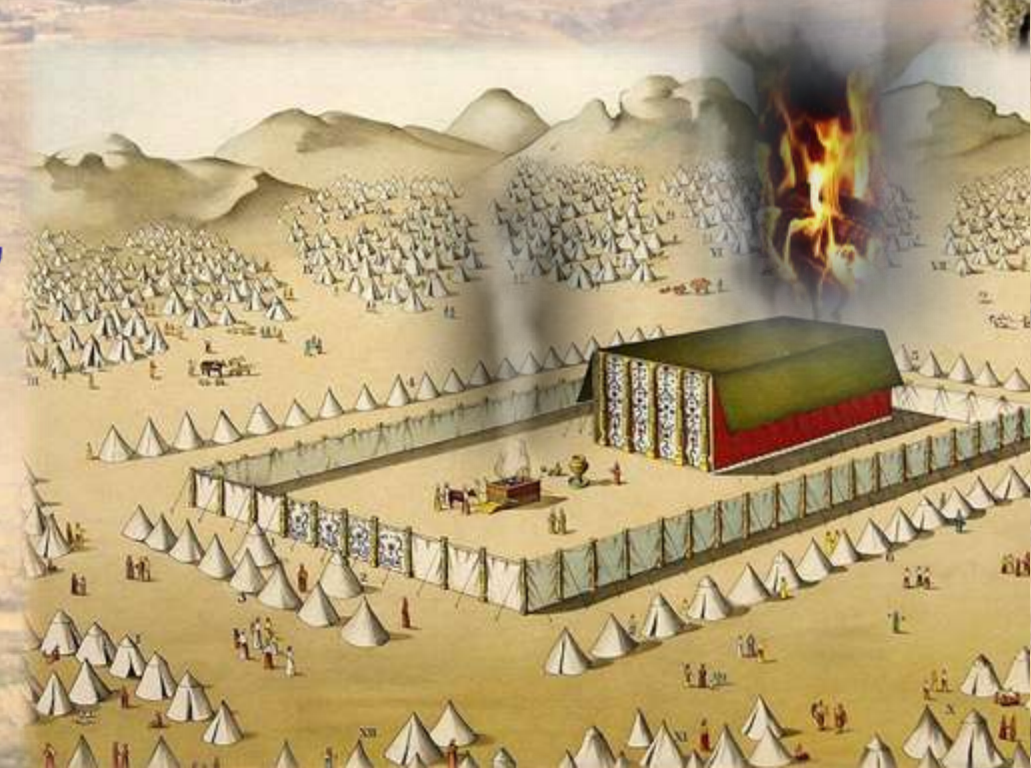
... Naphtali ... Ephraim and Manasseh,

but you will not cross over into it.”**

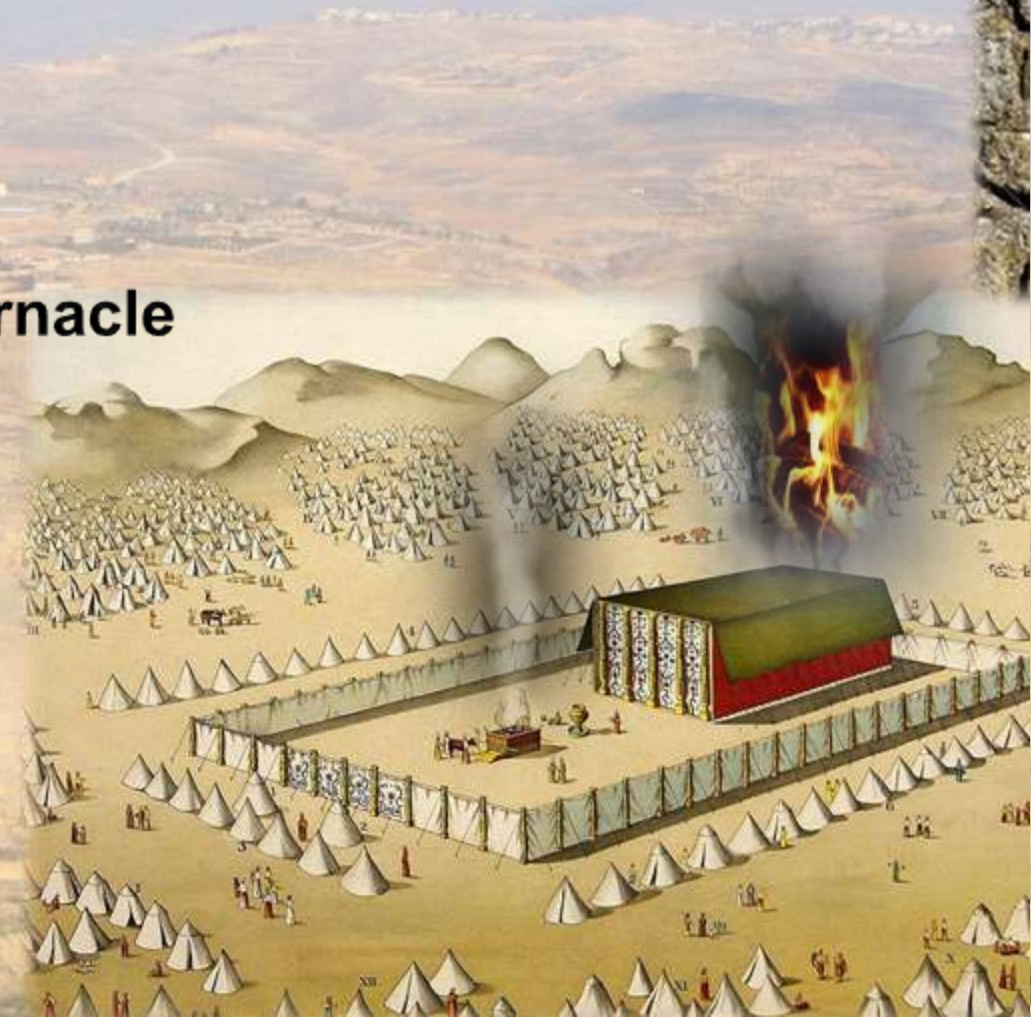

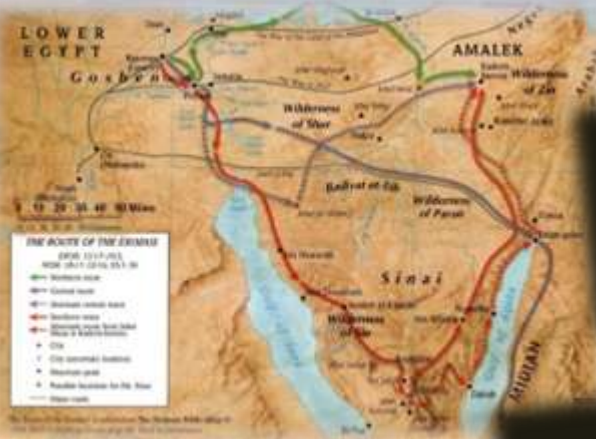

**We left Exodus with Israel at Mt Horeb
or Jebel Musa in Sinai**

Thutmose III, 1479–1425 B.C. ...

**Egypt's greatest conqueror
or "the Napoleon of Egypt"**

**Said he captured 350 cities from the
Euphrates in Assyria to Nubia
a *HUGE* Kingdom, c. 1457 B.C.**

Also called BUILDING PHARAOH – 50+ temples

**Solomon finished Temple 1 Kgs 6:1 in
418th year from Exodus**

**1446 B.C. minus 40 years of WONDERING
Places Numbers & Deuteronomy c. 1406 B.C.**

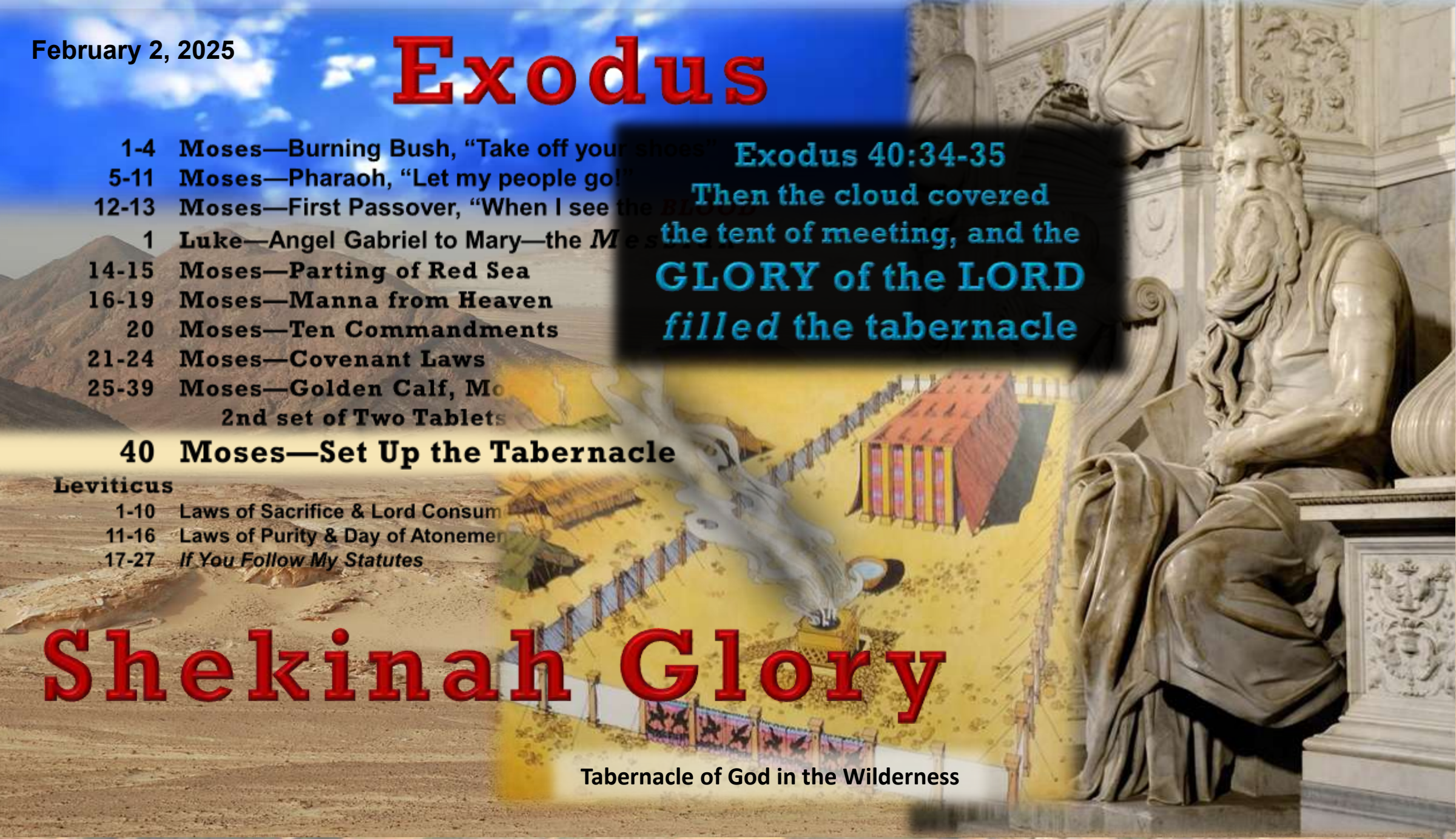

came out of Egypt.

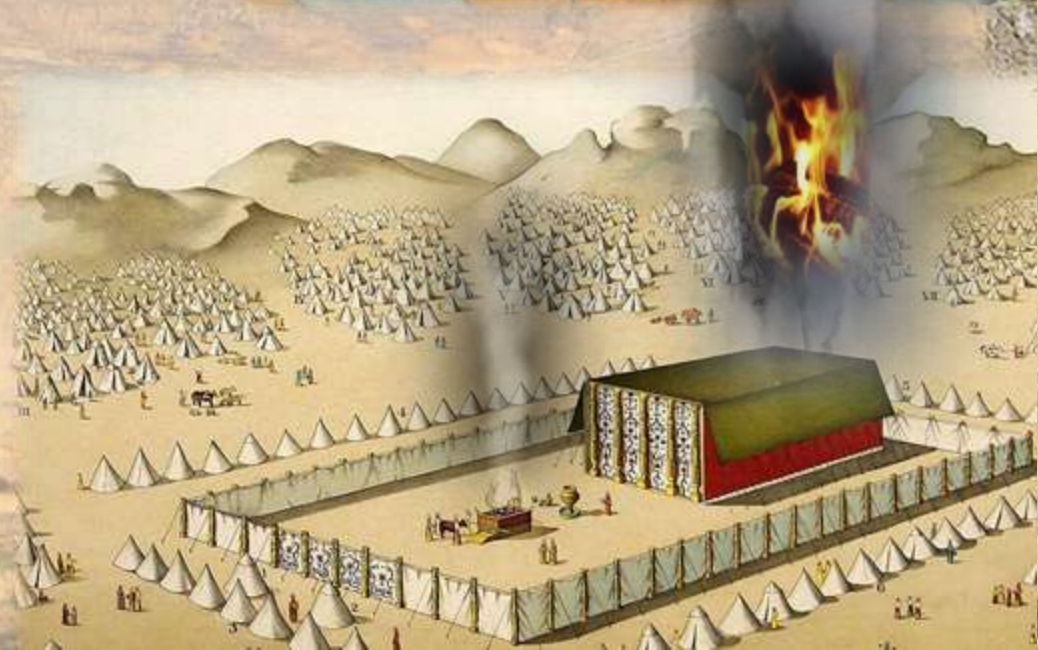
AFTER 2 years of rugged wandering . . .

Numbers 1

First Census – **NOT** counting the Tribe of Levi

1:51 Whenever the tabernacle is to move, the Levites are to take it down ... set up....

ANYONE else who approaches it is to be

PUT TO DEATH.

Then the Levites are commanded to camp around the Tabernacle

Numbers 2

FINISH the census

2:1 ... Israelites ... families.

All the men ... number 603,550



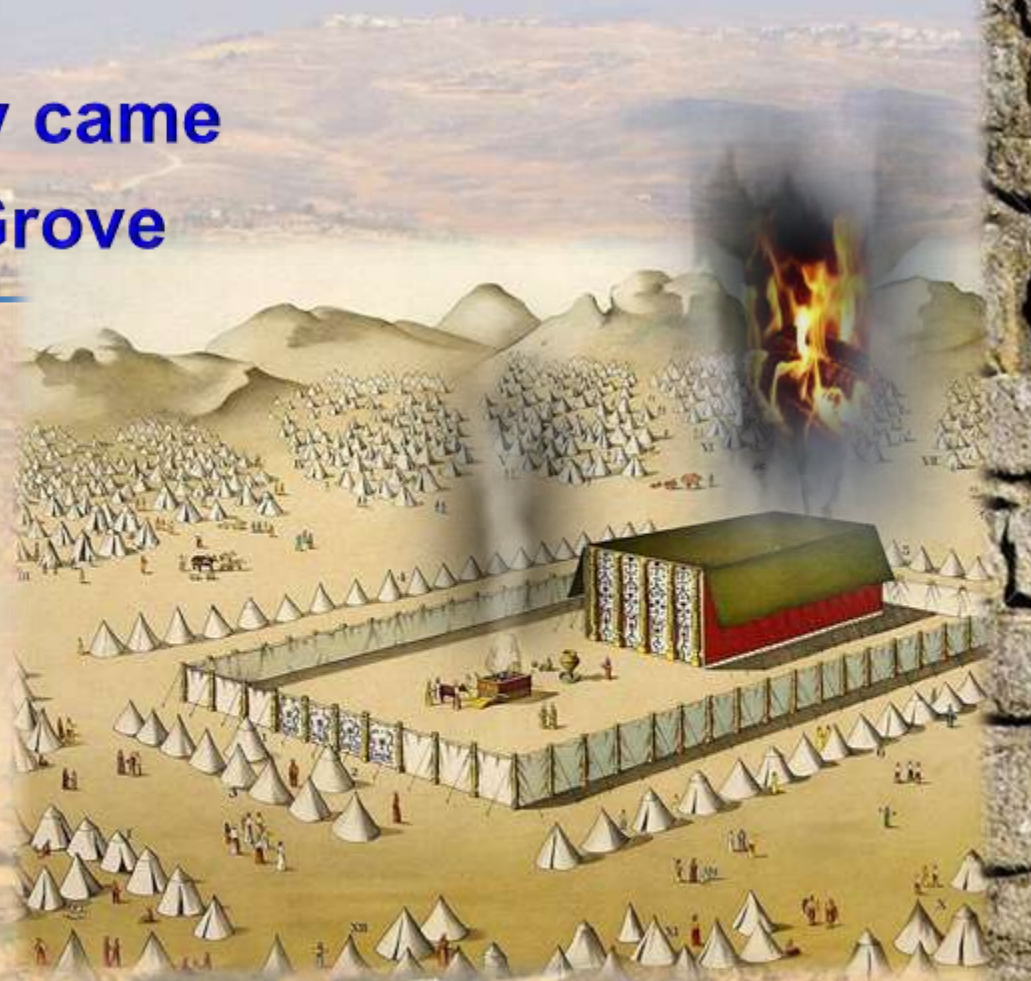

Numbers 3

Levites brought to Aaron to sanctify

Names of the Levite CLANS given

Clans COUNTED – 22,273 First Born Males

Levied a type of TAX on excessive Levites

Number 4 – Duties of U-Haulers

AFTER Aaron & sons PACK up **Ark of the Covenant**

Kohathite clan Levites, men 30-50

to CARRY Tabernacle stuff

3:16 Eleazar son of Aaron, the priest, is to have charge of the oil for the light.

Gershonite clan men 30-50 – curtains, ropes

Merarite clan men 30-50 – frames, cross bars, posts



Numbers 5

1-4 Send away impure & diseased

5-10 Restitution for wrongs

5:9 All the sacred contributions the Israelites bring to a priest will belong to him.

11-31 Test of Unfaithful Wife – on the

“Feeling” of the husband – Wife must VOW
cursed if lying – Nothing on the Husband

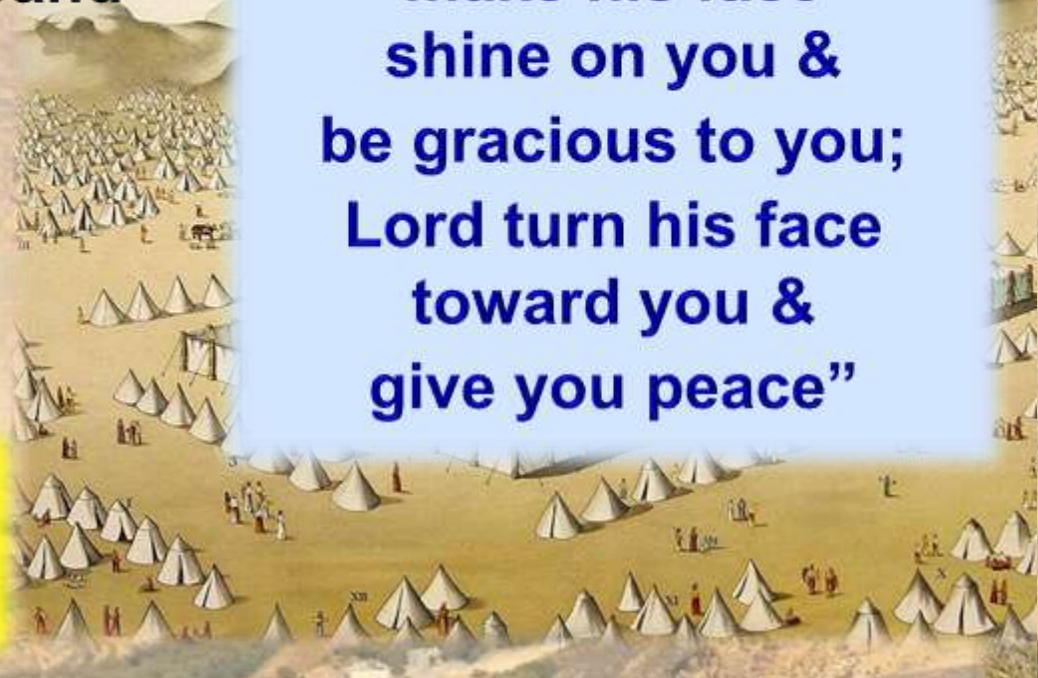
Numbers 6

1-21 Nazirite Vow to Lord:

No Wine, No Hair Cutting
after “time of their dedication”
free to drink wine

22-27 Lord tells Moses to tell Aaron
to ***Bless*** to Israelites

The BLESSING
“The Lord bless you

make his face
shine on you &
be gracious to you;
Lord turn his face
toward you &
give you peace”

Dedication of Tabernacle

Offerings Ordered for 12 Days from 12 Tribes

7:89 When Moses ENTERED the tent of meeting to speak
with the **LORD**, Moses HEARD THE VOICE

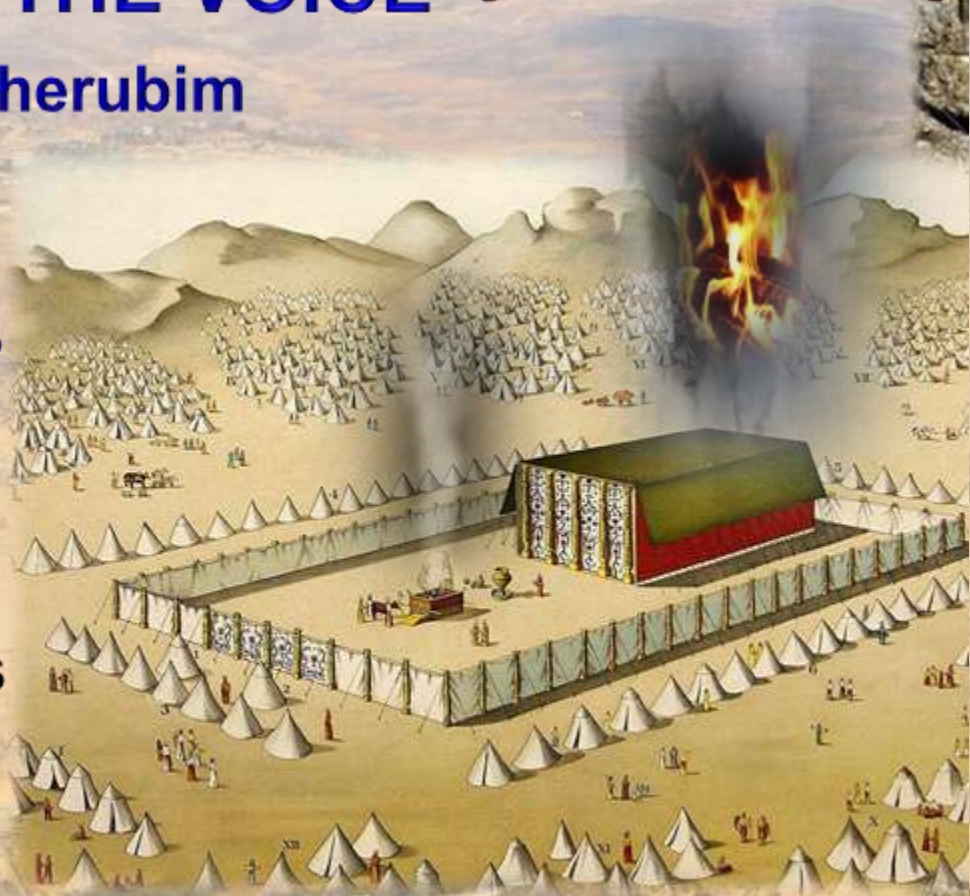
speaking to him from between the two cherubim
above the atonement cover on
the Ark of the Covenant Law.

9:21 Sometimes the CLOUD stayed
only from evening till morning,
when it lifted in the morning, they set out.

Whether by day or by night,

WHENEVER the cloud lifted, they set out.

Imagine WITNESSING every DAY

Imagine seeing the FIRE at NIGHT—ALL NIGHT

For Israelites, things **STILL** very tough, rugged—a **HARD ROAD!**

And **VERY, VERY** Hard for Moses & Aaron & Tribal Chiefs

But everyday there's a new thing comin'

The ways of an oriental view

The sheriff & his buddies with their samurai swords

You can even hear the music at night

So Moses, Aaron ... along with the
Cooks ... Shepherds ... Seamstresses

Levites ... musicians ...

Father, Mothers, Grandparents ...

Sick & Weak ... are now

ALL their bags are PACKED

10:35-36 closes with a type of poem
Whenever the ARK set out, Moses said,
“Rise up, Lord!
May your enemies be scattered;
may your foes flee before you.”

³⁶ Whenever ARK came to rest, Moses said,
“Return, Lord, to the countless thousands of Israel.”

I can't avoid seeing Indiana Jones
instructing the Feds at the University
On this verse, C.H. Spurgeon said in 1861
their guiding-star was the visible presence
of God in the pillar of CLOUD by day
and pillar of FIRE by night.



10:35-36 C.H. Spurgeon continues in 1861:

Wherever they were, God was their dwelling-place....

by day they were covered with his cloud, and

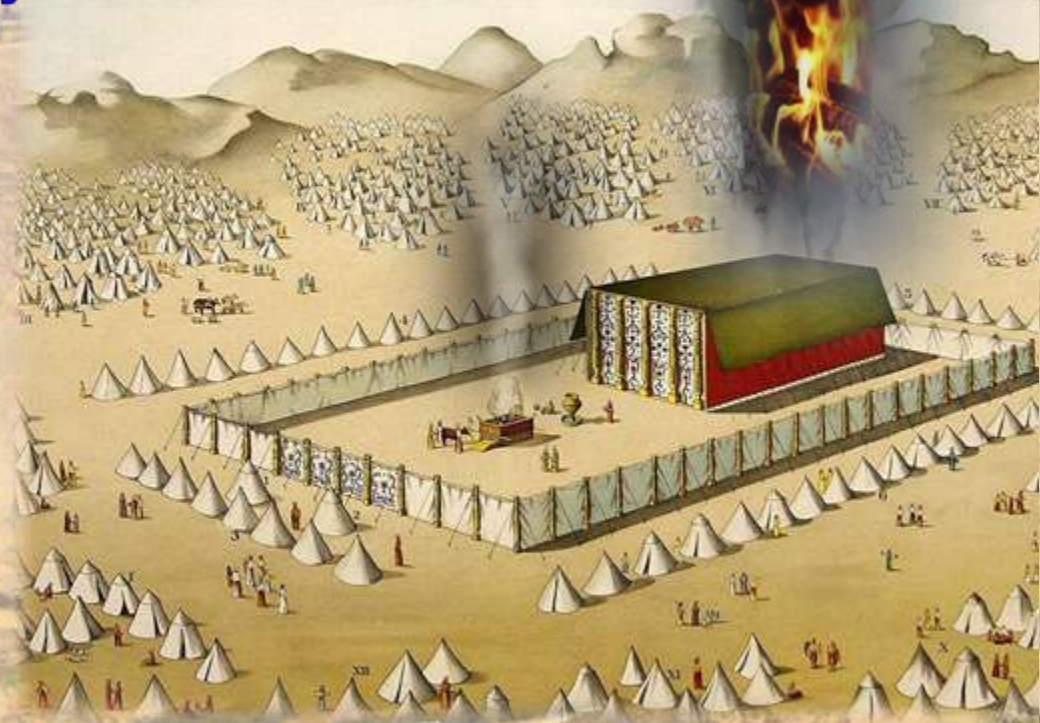
they dwelt under the vast canopy like princes in a pavilion;

by night they were covered with its fiery lustre,

**and they rested under it with a light that never made glad
the earth by night save only to their eyes.**

God's wings were always over them;

**He carried them all the days of old, and
they did really rest and dwell in HIM.**



10:35-36 C.H. Spurgeon continues in 1861:

Today, in our Father's House there are many mansions,
and it was true of them yesterday that in
their Father's house were many tents ... in *their* Father's House.

This, too, is true of the entire Church;
always wandering, yet never far from home:
unhoused yet always in palaces,

sometimes destitute, afflicted, tormented,
yet always clothed ... always feasting ...
deserted, yet not alone,

forsaken, yet multiplied;

left, yet still abiding with Him
that filleth all in all.
