Driftwood & forest debris BURN easily SIN – what a term – can BURN too If not properly handled,

Driftwood burning can be TOXIC

Driftwood BURNING w salt content especially from the ocean

- Can produces dioxins & furans
- ✓ DIOXINS are chemicals harmful to humans & animals
- ✓ FURAN—heterocyclic aromatic organic compound

Psalm 38 – title same as Psalm 70

1 LORD, do not rebuke me in your anger or discipline me in your wrath.

Psalm 38 is among the seven **Penitential Psalms** 6, 32, 38, 51, 102, 130, 143

O.T. Scholars Keil & Delitzsch four chronologically IF, if Psalms 6, 38, 51, 32 refer to David's affair with Bathsheba Keil & Delitzsch place Psalm 32 last – seems to follow others In Both Psalms 6 & 38 – verse 1 is IDENTICAL

- ✓ Psalms 6, 32, 51 are similar in the deep shame & depression
- ✓ Psalm 32 seems to be a relief thanksgiving LEARNING
- ✓ Psalm 32:1 Blessed is the one whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.

APPEARS Psalms 6, 38, 51, 32 are about David's Affair

Psalm 38 - title same as Psalm 70

- 1 LORD, do not rebuke me in your anger or discipline me in your wrath.
- O.T. Scholars Keil & Delitzsch (Carl Friedrich Keil & Franz Delitzsch) in their very respected commentary on Psalm 38 observed:
- If we regard David's adultery as the occasion of it (2 Samuel 12), then Psalms 6, 38, 51, 32 form a chronological series.
- David is distressed both in mind & body, forsaken by his friends, and regarded by his foes as one who is cast off for ever.
- The fire of divine anger burns within him like a fever, and the divine withdrawal as it were rests upon him like darkness.
 - But he fights his way by PRAYER through this fire & this darkness to the bright confidence of FAITH.

Psalm 38 - title same as Psalm 70 - David Psalm for Remembrance

- 1 LORD, do not rebuke me in your anger or discipline me in your wrath.
- Psalm 38 with "remembrance" 1 Hebrew word used only 4x in O.T.
 - KJV "to bring remembrance" ~ NIV "a Petition" ~ Holman Christian "for remembrance"
 - > 2 uses of "remembrance" in titles of Psalms 38 & 70 then
- 1 Kings 17:18 she said unto Elijah, "What have I to do with thee,
 O thou man of God? Art thou come unto me
 to call my sin TO REMEMBRANCE, and to slay my son?"
- then oddly translated in Amos 6 God condemning Israel's PRIDE
 - Amos 6:10 he that burneth him, to bring out the bones out of the house, ... Then shall he say, "Hold thy tongue, for
 - we may not DARE MENTION the name of the LORD."

Lot on the Life of David ... yet look close

His greatest grief is at the death of his newborn son from Bathsheba

Yet after David's blindness & self-deception is so brutally, painfully, clearly exposed by Prophet Nathan

David's murder to steal Bathsheba SEEMS to be his greatest

painful GUILT in Psalm 38

Be careful of this Psalm

In the Bible, next to Judas' betraying Jesus, David's *taking* of Bathsheba & *murdering* her husband Uriah is the greatest "SIN with Guilt"

God opened the earth for Dathan under Moses & smoked Sodom & Gomorrah – yet NEITHER Dathan nor Sodom

NEITHER of them LOVED God like David

This is not merely a Psalm, but the bleeding of a humbled heart







Narrator in *Pilgrim's Progress* said:

"I saw a man clothed with rags ... great burden upon his back.

I ... saw him open the book ... read as he read, he wept & trembled; & not being able longer to contain,

he brake out, with a lamentable cry, saying, 'What shall I do?'"



Guilt, Shame, Contrition come to those with a HEART many times in proportion to How much they LOVE God Love Honor, Love Justice

If David was a mere criminal,
He would ONLY feel SHAME
about getting CAUGHT

6-10 Back Sears in Pain - Heart Pounds

- 6 I am BOWED down and brought very low; all day long I go about mourning.
- 7 My BACK is filled with searing PAIN; there is NO HEALTH in my BODY.

- 9 All my LONGINGS LIE OPEN before you, Lord; my sighing is not hidden from you.
- 10 My HEART POUNDS, my strength fails me; even the LIGHT has gone from my EYES.

NOT an uglier betrayal of Uriah who was faithful to the end of his LIFE Young wife Bathsheba in the hands of a Super-Successful KIN G



David already had 7 wives of record before Bathsheba

Michal, Ahinoam, Abigail, Maachah, Haggith, Abital, Eglah Bathsheba was #8 of record Bible says he took "OTHER WIVES"

No knows how many concubines



- 11-20 Friends Forsake, Foes Fight PAIN Is Ever with Me
- 11 My friends and companions avoid me because of my WOUNDS; my neighbors STAY FAR AWAY.
- 12 Those who want to KILL me set their TRAPS, those who would harm me talk of my ruin; ALL DAY LONG they scheme and LIE.
- That CEO & HR Director better have a good retirement ...
- YET read this Psalm, perhaps the GREATEST Confession in the Bible
- NONE of us have MURDERED for a Fling ... yet do notice Psalm 38
 - Here is a man so HONEST he writes a SONG about his GUILT

David TELLS the world how terribly he felt ...

David CONFESSES in clearer terms than ... than ...

I suspect ANY of us could do on our BEST day!

- 11-20 Friends Forsake, Foes Fight PAIN Is Ever with Me
- 13 I am like the DEAF, who cannot HEAR, like the MUTE, who cannot speAk;
- 14 I have become like one who does not hear, Can you feel David's whose mouth can offer no reply.
- 15 LORD, I wait for you; you will answer, Lord my God.
- 16 For I said, "Do not let them gloat or exalt themselves over me when my feet slip."

Clearly, though we have NEVER even thought of doing what he did Clearly, David is open & honest about his HEART to GOD

And God is working David over – **DESERVEDLY!**

Can you feel David's LONELINESS?

ISOLATION?

Can you feel David's longing for GOD?



- 11-20 Friends Forsake, Foes Fight PAIN Is Ever with Me
- 17 For I am about to FALL, and my PAIN is ever with me.
- 18 I confess my INIQUITY. I am troubled by my sin.
- 19 Many have become my enemies without cause; those who hate me without reason are numerous.
- Ever have a "Fair Weather Friend" ONLY there IF you are KING?
- Even though David was WORSE than the CEO on camera ...
 - David was in the lineage of a Promised Covenant that led to Jesus
- 20 Those who repay my good with evil lodge accusations against me, though I seek only to do what is good.

Larger lesson is "How to Be Honest to God?"

and when the Prodigal Son comes HOME?

21-22 Forsake Me Not - Come Quickly

21 LORD, DO NOT FORSAKE me; DO NOT BE FAR from me, my God.

22 COME QUICKLY to help me, my Lord and my Savior.

God can forgive David enough to allow a lineage through Bathsheba Greatest Lesson of all, probably already guessed, is on
