Paul wrote from Corinth c. A.D. 57 ... Paul wrote the Galatians first, then the Romans **TOUGH** on the Galatians ... **EASY** on Romans Paul had not been to Rome yet ... Yet his reputation was now far and wide ... Same gist in Galatians, only Romans is SMOOTHER Paul is his most diplomatic ... careful ... kind ... Who was Paul writing to? We see most of WHO in last chapters

### Romans 15:14-33 ... Who is Paul writing ...

- **<u>14</u>** I myself am convinced ... you're full of goodness
- **15-18** Yet I have written boldly ... to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles. Therefore I glory in Christ Jesus ...
- **<u>19-21</u>** I have fully proclaimed the gospel of Christ... ALL OVER ...
- **22** This is why I have often been hindered from coming to you...
- **<u>23-27</u>** Longs to see them and go to Spain ... via Jerusalem ...
- 30-32 I urge you ... to join me in my struggle by praying to God for me. Pray that I may be kept safe from the unbelievers in Judea.... so I may come to you....
- **<u>33</u>** The God of peace be with you all. Amen.

1-4 Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle and set apart for the gospel of God—the gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures regarding his Son, who as to his earthly life was a descendant of David, and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord.

**Romans 1:8-12 ... The Gospel Deference** 

- 8 First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your FAITH is being reported all over the world.
- 9-10 God, whom I serve in my spirit in preaching the gospel of his Son, is my witness how at all times; and I pray that now at last by God's will the way may be opened for me constantly I remember you in my prayers to come to you.
- 11-12 I long to see you so that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to make you strong—that is, that you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other's FAITH.



Romans 1:13-15 ... The Gospel Debt

- 13 I do not want you to be unaware, brothers and sisters, that I planned many times to come to you (but have been prevented from doing so until now) in order that I might have a harvest among you, just as I have had among the other Gentiles.
- 14 I am obligated both to Greeks and non-Greeks, both to the wise and the foolish.
- 15 That is why I am so eager to preach the gospel also to you who are in Rome.



Romans 1:16-17 ... The Gospel Declared

16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to EVERYONE WHO BELIEVES:

first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.

Parallel to 2 Cor. 5:21:
