After meeting with Rep Otto's office (chair of the appropriations corrections subcommittee) I was told that Chaplaincy had been restored to \$9.1M - same as current biennium. I had her double check figures and notes from Wednesday's workgroup meeting and she called me back to personally confirm. These numbers were for the House budget, which is where the real work of hashing out the details are taking place. The whole session is not over and these numbers have not been published yet, but I am so so so so excited - in a very reserved way of course!

I know that Rep Otto received personal visits and calls from folks involved in prison ministry speaking on behalf of chaplaincy. I also know that the tireless efforts of all the folks who have supported chaplaincy and all the reporters who have covered the story have helped monumentally!

Thanks be to God for this good news. We will remain diligent and grateful to Him for the way in which the Holy Spirit is moving the hearts of so many for this ministry.
